KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, J. W. D. Galloway, whose full name is John Wiles DuBose Galloway, a resident of Montevallo, Shelby County, Alabama, being over the age of twenty-one years and of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, declare and publish this to be my last will and testament, revoking all former wills which may have been made by me at any time heretofore.

FIRST: It is my will and desire that all of my just debts and funeral expenses shall be paid by my Executor, hereinafter named, as soon after my decease as practicable.

SECOND: I give, devise and bequeath to my brothers and sisters, seven (7) in number, all of my property, real, personal and mixed of every nature, kind and description, wheresoever situate, of which I may die seized and possessed, or to which I may be entitled at the time of my decease, said property to descend to and become the property of my brothers and sisters equally, share and share alike, to have and to hold unto my said brothers and sisters, absolutely. In the event, however, that any of my brothers or sisters shall predecease me, then I will and direct that my property, real, personal and mixed, shall descend to and become the property of such brothers and sisters who shall be living at the time of my death equally, share and share alike.

THIRD: I nominate and appoint my brother, Robert B. Galloway, and my sister, Polly G. Lester, to act jointly as Executor and Executrix of this my last will and testament, and I expressly declare that they shall not be required to give any bond for the performance of their duties hereunder; nor shall they be required to make any inventory of the property coming into their hands as Executor or Executrix, nor make any report to any court of their proceedings hereunder after the due probate of this will.
