KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, WHEREAS, default having been made in the payment of the indebtedness due by that promissory note and real estate mortgage securing payment of the same, executed by Lota Lawley, sometimes referred to as Loda Lawley; Lila Wayne Lawley Seale and husband, Owen Seale; Eleanor Ruth Lawley Boothe, and husband, Owen Boothe; Gerald Oscar Lawley and wife, Jean Lawley, being all of the heirs of O. T. Lawley, Deceased, to Shelby County Savings and Loan Association, and recorded in Mortgage Book 322, page 49, in the Probate Records of Shelby County, Alabama, which mortgage described the real estate hereinafter set out; and
