KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That in consideration of Twentytwo Thousand Three Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$22,315.00), to the undersigned grantors, in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we, Will D. Nix and wife, Lorraine Nix; Lydia N. Anderson, a widow; Edgar Roy Nix and wife, Mary Junita Nix; Mack Aron Nix and wife, Lurlene Nix; John W. Nix and wife, Cherry Lou Nix; George Archie Nix and wife, Faye Nix; Lula Mae Sherrer and husband, Bobby E. Sherrer; and Peggy Nix, a widow, (herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain sell and convey unto James Leon Nix and wife, Betty Joyce Nix, (herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, our undivided interest in and to the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

A portion of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 22 South, Range 3 West, more particularly described as follows: Begin at the N.W. corner of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the said Section, Township, and Range, and run Southerly along the West side of the said W $\frac{1}{2}$ for 2134.84 ft. to the North side of the George Nix land described in Deed Book 165, page 97, then turn an angle of 90°35'53" left and run Easterly along the North side of the George Nix land for 146.26 to an existing iron, then turn an angle of 89°57'14" right and run Southerly along the East side of the George Nix land for 26.47 ft. to the North side of the Bob Sherrer land as described in Deed Book 176, page 7, then turn an angle of 130°35'12" left and run 42.75 ft. along the North side of the Bob Sherrer land to the N.W. corner of the Bliss Nix land described in Deed Book 168, page 90, then continue along the same line Easterly along the North side of the Bliss Nix land for 100.00 ft. to the N.E. corner of the Bliss Nix land, then turn an angle of 90°00' to the right and run Southeasterly along the East side of the Bliss Nix land for 165.29 ft. to a point on the N.W. 80 ft. right of way of State Highway 119, then turn an angle of 90°00' left and run Northeasterly along the said right of way for 262.05 ft. to an existing iron, then turn an angle of 90°00' left and run Northwesterly 33.45 ft. to an existing iron, then turn an angle of 40°53'55" right and run Northerly for 1932.34 ft. to a point on the North side of the said W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, then turn an angle of 83°23'04" left and run Westerly along the North side of the said W $\frac{1}{2}$ for 526.54 ft. to point of beginning, containing 25.89 acres more or less.
