My name is CARRIDELL HORTON. I am 75 years of age and have been familiar with the occupation, use and possession of the following described land for a period in excess of 30 years:

The North 4½ acres of the South 19½ acres of the SE¼ of NW¼ of Section 4, Township 22, Range 1 East, Shelby County, Alabama.

The above property was one time owned by N. O. Norton, who was one and the same person as Oliver Horton. It is my understanding that the said N. O. Horton purchased an interest in said land from B. W. Horton back around the year 1918 and a deed appears of record from B. W. Horton to N. O. Horton in Deed Book 64, page 549; and it is my further understanding that in Deed Book 57, page 344 a deed appears of record naming the grantee in said deed as "W. B. Horton". I know that the said B. W. Horton and W. B. Horton was one and the same person and that his wife's name was Rosa L. Horton.

The said N. O. Horton left the above property, along with other property, to his widow, Georgie Horton who sold said property to my husband, LEWIS HORTON, in 1944. My husband and I sold the above property, along with other property, to Edgar Horton and his wife in 1962 and it is my understanding that said above property is now owned by William E.
