Before me, the undersigned authority, in and for said County and State,
personally appeared Charles Harris, also known as Chuck Harris, and C.H. Harris,
known to me and being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

That he is 71 years of age and presently resides at P.O. Box 100,
Siluria, Alabama; that he has been acquainted with the occupation, use and
possession of the following described property for the last 30 years:

From the Northwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34,
Township 20 South, Range 3 West run Easterly along the North boundary line of
the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 34, Twp 20 South, Range 3 West, 401.37 feet;
thence turn an angle of 37 degrees, 07 minutes to the right and run
Southeasterly 528.17 feet to the point of beginning of the land herein
described and conveyed; thence continue southeasterly along the last said
course for 80.0 feet; thence turn an angle of 101 degrees, 55 minutes to
the left and run Northeasterly 110.25 feet; thence turn an angle of 105
degrees, 01 minutes to the left and run northwesterly 107.64 feet; thence
turn an angle of 100 degrees, 08 minutes to the left and run Southerly
64.8 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

This land being a part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township
20 South, Range 3 West and being 0.187 acres, more or less.

In November, 1965, I purchased the above-described property from
Erah Mae Butler, widow of Gus E. Butler. The deed is recorded in Deed Book
251, page 714. I went into possession of the property when I purchased it.

Further deposing, affiant says that he has assessed and paid taxes
on said property for each and every year that he has owned the same; that
no other person, firm or corporation has paid taxes on said property other
than himself.

Further deposing, affiant says that at the present time he owns said
land in fee simple, and since the time he first knew the land it has been
owned by him, and his predecessors in title and has been occupied by him
actually, exclusively, openly, notoriously, hostilely and continuously and he
has never heard the title questioned in any way.
