FINAL DECREE OF DIVORCE

This cause, coming on to be heard, was submitted for final decree upon the pleadings and proof as noted. Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court as follows:

FIRST: That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Respondent are dissolved, and the said Lorene M. McElroy is forever divorced from the said Vance A. McElroy.

SECOND: That neither the Complainant nor the Respondent shall again marry except to each other until sixty (60) days after the date of this Decree. If an appeal from this Decree is taken within sixty (60) days neither the Complainant nor the Respondent shall marry again except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

THIRD: That the care and custody of the minor children of the parties, namely, Randy McElroy age 16, Reginald McElroy age 13, Shannon McElroy age 6, is awarded to Complainant.

FOURTH: That Respondent pay to Complainant the sum of Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars per week for support and maintenance of the minor children of the parties, and said payments shall continue until the last of said children comes of age or becomes self-supporting, whichever shall first occur.

FIFTH: That the Respondent shall provide for and pay all of the major medical expenses reasonably incurred by and on behalf of the minor children of the parties or, in the alternative, provide adequate medical insurance for said children.

SIXTH: That the Respondent shall have reasonable visitation privileges with the minor children of the parties.

SEVENTH: That the Complainant is awarded all of the furniture, furnishings and appliances which the parties have heretofore used in keeping house, to have as her own and to do with as she deems fit and proper. The Respondent is awarded all of his personal belongings.

EIGHTH: That the residence at Route 1 Box 67, Alabaster, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, legally described as:

From the southeast corner of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, run north along the east boundary line of the said $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 20 South, Range 3 West 682 feet; thence turn an angle of 56 deg. 50 min. to the left and run 430.6 feet to

the point of beginning of the land herein conveyed; thence turn an angle of 78 deg. 05 min. to the right and run 117.2 feet; thence turn an angle of 90 deg. 12 min. to the left and run 97.85 feet; thence turn an angle of 89 deg. 48 min. to the left and run 96.4 feet; thence turn an angle of 78 deg. 05 min. to the left and run 100 feet to the point of beginning, this being a part of the $SE^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of $SE^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 34, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, and containing 0.242 acres, more or less,

shall be and is hereby decreed the sole property of the Com- plainant.

NINTH: That the automobile of the parties shall become and is hereby decreed the sole property of the Complainant.

TENTH: That Respondent shall pay to Complainant for her Solicitor of Record, Donald Hugh Jones, the sum of Three Hundred Fifty (\$350.00) Dollars as Solicitor's fee for representation of Complainant in this cause.

ELEVENTH: That the costs of Court accrued herein are hereby taxed against the Respondent for the collection of which let execution issue and if returned "no property found" then let execution for costs issue against the Complainant.
