

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That whereas the undersigned Max Cleland, as Administrator of Veterans' Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America, is the present holder and owner of that certain mortgage by William I. Armstrong and wife, Lucille Armstrong, dated the 24th day of December, 1957, which mortgage is recorded in record volume 252, page 223 et seq., in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and no other person, whatsoever, has any right, title, interest or claim in or to said mortgage or in or to the note thereby secured or in or to the debt thereby evidenced; and

WHEREAS, the indebtedness secured by said mortgage has now been paid in full, the undersigned Max Cleland, as Administrator of Veterans' Affairs does hereby acknowledge such payment and does hereby cancel said mortgage and does hereby release and discharge from the lien thereof the real estate therein described, viz:

Begin at the SW corner of $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 31, Tp. 20, Range 2 East; thence North 87 deg. & 45' East 97 feet to a point on the E right of way of Highway #25 for a point of beginning; thence N 87 deg. & 45' E 269.2 feet to a stake; thence N 19 deg & 30' E 166 feet to a stake; thence N 70 deg. & 30' W 210 feet to a stake on the E right of way of Highway #25; thence with right of way S, 19 deg. & 30' West, 125 feet; thence continue said right of way south, 35 deg. & 25' W, 146.0 feet to the point of beginning, containing one acre, more or less.

Also, begin at the SW corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 31, and run N 87 deg. & 45' E, along the south line of said forty acres, 366.2 feet to the point of beginning; thence run N 19 deg & 30' E, 66 feet; thence in a southeasterly direction South 70 deg & 30' E 428.8 feet to a point on the S line of said Forty acres, which point is 461.5 feet East of the beginning point; thence S 87 deg. & 45' West along the S line of said Forty acres, 461.5 feet to the point of beginning.
