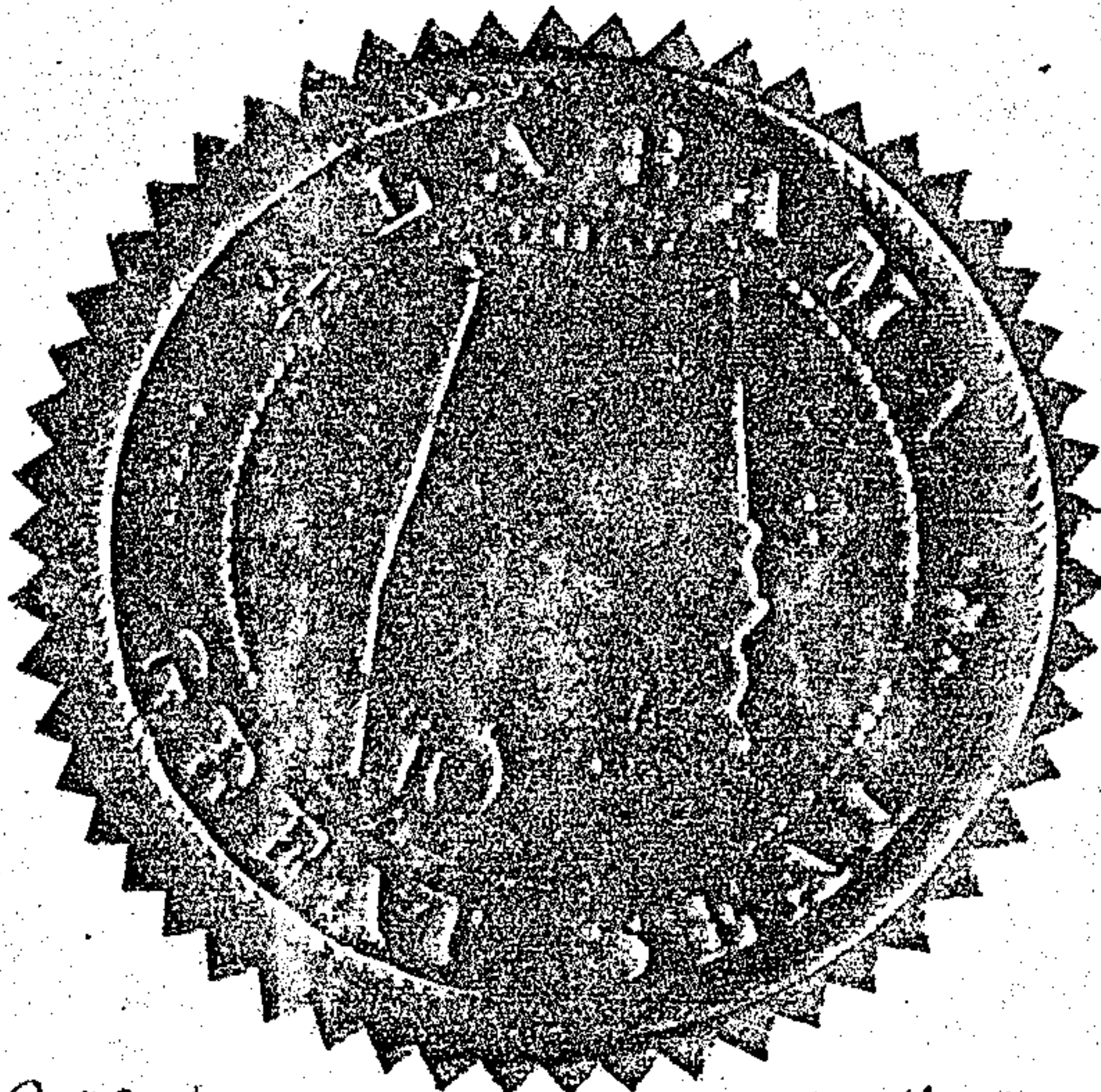

Know all men, That *John Harliss* of the County of *Shelby* having made complete payment for *the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of* of Section No. *Sixteen* at Township No. *Twentyone* Range *Three West* containing *forty* Acres, in pursuance of the Act entitled, "An Act to authorize the sales of Sixteenth Sections, and for other purposes," approved January 16th, 1828.

There is therefore granted by the State of Alabama, unto the said *John Harliss* the *tract* of Land above described, with the appurtenances, unto the said *John Harliss* his heirs and assigns for ever.
