I, MAGNOLIA C. JONES, a resident of Jefferson County, State of Alabama, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this instrument as and for my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills and Codicils thereto heretofore made by me.

ITEM I.

I direct that all my debts, including the expenses of my last illness and funeral, shall be paid out of my estate by my executors hereinafter named, as soon as possible after my death.

ITEM II.

All the rest, residue and remainder of my property, both real and personal, of whatever kind and character, and wheresoever situated, I give, devise and bequeath to my children, MARGIE J. BENTLEY, BYRON H. JONES and ROBERT L. JONES, in equal shares, per stirpes; provided, however, that if any of my said children should predecease me leaving issue surviving at the time of my death, then my deceased child's equal share shall be paid over and distributed absolutely to such surviving issue, in equal shares, it being my intention that the issue of a deceased child of mine are to take among them only the share which my child would have taken had he or she been living. However, since my child, MARGIE J. BENTLEY, does not now have any children, and it is doubtful that she will ever have any children, I hereby direct that if my said child, MARGIE J. BENTLEY, shall predecease me not leaving any surviving issue, then I direct that her said share shall pass to

her husband, WILLIAM G. BENTLEY. In the event that my said child, MARGIE J. BENTLEY, and her husband, WILLIAM G. BENTLEY, shall predecease me leaving no surviving issue, then the bequest to such deceased child of mine shall lapse and shall be distributed in equal shares, per stirpes, among my surviving children and the surviving issue of any other deceased child of mine. In the event that either BYRON H. JONES or ROBERT L. JONES shall predecease me leaving no surviving issue, then the bequest to such deceased child of mine shall lapse and shall be distributed in equal shares, per stirpes, among my surviving children and the surviving issue of any other deceased child of mine; and I direct that WILLIAM G. BENTLEY shall be treated as and take as a surviving issue of my child, MARGIE J. BENTLEY, provided said MARGIE J. BENTLEY does not have any surviving issue at the time of my death.

ITEM III.

I hereby nominate and appoint my three children, MARGIE J. BENTLEY, BYRON H. JONES and ROBERT L. JONES, as Co-Executors of my estate. If any of them should predecease me, or fail to qualify for any reason, or having qualified, should die, resign, or become incapacitated, then I appoint the remaining one or both of them, as the case may be, as Executor or Executrix.

I direct that none of my Co-Executors hereby nominated and appointed shall be required to furnish bond or other security, or to file an inventory or appraisal of my estate in any court. The administration of my estate shall be expedited as quickly as is practicable after my death and distribution made to beneficiaries herein named, not later than one year after the date of my death.

Any one or more of my Co-Executors shall have the right to resign at any time and for any reason, and without leave of court, by filing an instrument of resignation with the clerk of the court in which this Will is probated.
