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Before me, a Notary Public in and for said County and State, personally appeared W. M. Varnon, who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is W. M. Varnon. I am 43 years of age and reside at 610 Parsons Drive, Hueytown, Jefferson County, Alabama. I am a land surveyor registered and licensed by the State of Alabama, by registration number being 9324.

I have recently prepared a re-survey of a portion of Block 3, as shown on map of J. E. Bozeman, Civil Engineer, of One Hundred Acres at Birmingham Junction on E.T.V. and G Railroad, said map being recorded in Deed Book 14 at page 239, Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, at the request of Adrian Woolley, Sr., Executor of the Last Will and Testament of Carrie Mae Woolley, Deceased. The re-survey which I prepared was dated 3-13-78 and has now been recorded as the Carrie Mae Woolley Subdivision in Map Book 7 at page 46, Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

The North line of said Carrie Mae Woolley Subdivision as surveyed by me and as shown in Map Book 7 at page 46 in said Probate Office is the South line of Birmingham Street in the Town of Wilton, Shelby County, Alabama, and as is shown by said subdivision map of One Hundred Acres At Birmingham Junction on E.T.V. and G. Railroad which is recorded in Deed Book 14 at page 239 in said Probate Office; The West line of said Carrie Mae Woolley Subdivision as surveyed by me (i.e., the West line of Lot No. 1 and the West line of Lot No. 3 for said subdivision) is the same as the West line of Lot No. 15 and the West line of Lot No. 16 of said subdivision as shown in Deed Book 14 at page 239; and the South or Southeast line of said Carrie Mae Woolley Subdivision as surveyed by me is the North right of way line of Shelby County Highway No. 8, as it is presently located.

In establishing the West line of said Carrie Mae Woolley Subdivision as surveyed by me and as shown in Map Book 7 at page 46 (i.e., in establishing the West line of Lot No. 1 and the West line of Lot No. 3 of said Subdivision) I found certain points and set said line after consultation with

Mr. Amos Cory, a Registered Land Surveyor, who was simultaneously making a survey for the owners of the property lying to the West of and adjacent to the West line/of said Carrie Mae Woolley Subdivision. The West line of said Carrie Mae Woolley Subdivision as located by me and as shown on my plat which is recorded in Map Book 7 at page 46 in said Probate Office is in agreement with and conforms to the survey of Mr. Cory, and there is no dispute to my knowledge as to the actual location on the ground of the West line of said Carrie Mae Woolley Subdivision as surveyed by me, nor are there any other disputes known to me as to the various corners and lines as established by me and as shown on said Carrie Mae Woolley Subdivision which is recorded in Map Book 7 at page 46, Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.
