Dear Mr. Ellis:

I have completed a preliminary review of the abstract of title which you have submitted in support of your request for a patent to__

- (1) the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 and,
- (2) 40 acres in the South 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4

of Section 16, Township 22 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama.

In conferring with the Secretary of State's Office, I learned that there are two patents of record in the Secretary of State's Office which convey the entire Northeast 1/4 of Section 16, Township 22 South, Range 3 West in Shelby County. You may obtain certified copies of these patents directly from the Secretary of State's Office. It would appear that the existence of these two patents negates the necessity of obtaining a patent to item 2 above.

Before I can process your request for a patent to item 1 above, please send me the following: (1) a check for \$2.00 made payable to the Secretary of State and, (2) a certified copy of the Registers Deed from N. A. Graham to Frank R. King recorded in D. Book 4, page 415.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE STATE OF ALABAMA grants the tract of land above described with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said W. M. Nix, deceased, his heirs, successors, or assigns forever.
