That all Court costs accrued in Case No. E-1270-76 since June 1,

1978 will be paid one-half by the Plaintiff and the other one-half by the Defendants, for which let execution issue if not paid within 30 days after entry of this Judgment.

That the Register of this Court will serve this Judgment by mailing a copy thereof to all Attorneys of Record and to the Defendant Birmingham Trust National Bank and to the Court Appointed Surveyor.



