I, Myra Browne Koenig, a widow, a resident of the City of Mountain Brook, Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills heretofore made by me.

ITEM ONE. I direct that all of my just debts, including the expenses of my last illness and funeral, shall first be paid out of my estate by my Executor hereinafter named, as soon as practicable after my death.

ITEM TWO. I give and bequeath that portion of my remaining estate consisting of cash in hand and all monies in checking accounts, savings accounts, savings and loan accounts, certificates of deposit, and the like, as follows:

(a) I give and bequeath the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) to my daughter Myra Koenig Lewis, now residing in Montgomery, Alabama; but in the event of the death of my said daughter prior to my death then I give and bequeath said sum, equally and share and share alike per stirpes and not per capita, to the descendants of my said daughter who are living at the time of my death.

(b) The rest and remainder of said monies referred to in this ITEM TWO I give and bequeath equally and share and share alike to my said daughter Myra Koenig Lewis and to my son Frederick G. Koenig, Jr., now residing in Mountain Brook, Alabama; but in the event of the death of either of my said children prior to my death then I give and bequeath to the legal descendants of any said deceased child of mine who are living at the time of my death the share which such deceased child would have taken if living, equally and share and share alike per stirpes and not per capita.

ITEM THREE. All of the rest, residue and remainder of my property, real, personal and mixed, of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever situated, I give, devise and bequeath equally and share and share alike to my said daughter Myra Koenig Lewis and my said son Frederick G. Koenig, Jr., if they are both living at the time of my death. If my said son Frederick G. Koenig, Jr., is not living at the time of my death then I give, devise and bequeath all of my said property above referred to in this ITEM THREE to my said daughter Myra Koenig Lewis, if she be living at the time of my death. If my said daughter Myra Koenig Lewis is not living at the time of my death then I give, devise and bequeath equally and share and share alike per stirpes and not per capita to the descendants of my said daughter who are living at the time of my death the equal share or the whole, as the case may be, of my said property above referred to in this ITEM THREE to which my said daughter would have been entitled hereunder if she had been living at the time of my death. Should I leave with this my said last will and testament a list in my handwriting dated concurrently with or subsequent to the date of this my said last will and testament and signed by me setting out certain specific articles of personalty which I wish to go to my respective children it will be my intention thereby to have divided such personal property equally between them and it will be my desire that they respect such division. I hereby vest in my Executor full power and authority to accept and follow said list as a fair and equal division of the property listed therein for all purposes under this my said last will and testament.

ITEM FOUR. I hereby constitute and appoint my son, Frederick G. Koenig, Jr., as executor of this my last will and testament, if he be living at the time of my death; in the event of the death of my said son prior to my death or of his inability or unwillingness to act as such executor, I hereby constitute and appoint my daughter, Myra Koenig Lewis, as executrix of this my last will and testament in his place and stead. I hereby exempt my said executor or executrix, as the case may be, from making any bond, filing any inventory, or making any report, appraisement, or partial or final settlement of my estate in any court, such bond, inventory, report, appraisement, or settlement being hereby expressly waived; and I direct that my said

executor or executrix shall not be liable to anyone for any loss or damage to any or all of my property resulting from any cause whatsoever. My said executor or executrix, as the case may be, shall take charge of, manage, and control all of the assets of my estate, and shall have the power to hold or to sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of at public or private sale any or all of the assets of such estate without order of court, to borrow any and all money deemed advisable for the protection and proper administration of the estate and to pledge or mortgage any assets of the estate as security therefor without order of court, to renew or extend any indebtedness or obligation against the estate or any assets thereof without order of court, to invest and reinvest the corpus of or income from any part of such estate without order of court, and to exercise in such manner as he or she may choose without order of court the same powers over all of the assets and in the settlement of the liabilities of my estate which I would have if living.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the said Myra Browne Zoenig, have hereunto set my hand and seal on this the 10th day of August, 1967, hereby declaring the instrument contained on this page and the preceding page (which preceding page I have identified by signing in the margin thereof) to be my last will and testament.
