McClusky and/or wife, Gleen Marie McClusky, nor was there any overlappage or dispute concerning the boundary lines of the subject property and the property conveyed to Norman D. Ledlow and wife, Nickey Ledlow, and Glenn Thomas McClusky, Sr. and wife, Marie McCluskey as recorded in Deed Book 304, page 610 all in said Probate Records. There has never been any dispute, whatsoever, concerning the boundary lines between subject property owned by Sheri S. Rich and Claude R. Rich, and any of the McClusky parcels.

Ada Stokes was the surviving widow of W. Y. Stokes. W. Y. Stokes died more than ten years ago without leaving a last will and testament, and the following named were all of the heirs at law of W. Y.
