Scott, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Kimberly-Clark Corporation, all pine and hardwood sawtimber and pulpwood from the following described property:

East Half of Northeast Quarter, all that part of the East Half of Southeast Quarter North of the Creek, and all that part of the Northwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter South and East of the Simsville paved road, all in Section 30, Township 20 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama,

together with full and free right of ingress and egress to and from said land at any and all times until the expiration of nine (9) months from the date of the execution of this deed, for the purpose of cutting and removing said timber, but after said time, grantee shall have no further rights or interest in said land or timber and at the expiration of said time, said land and all uncut timber shall revert to the grantor herein.
