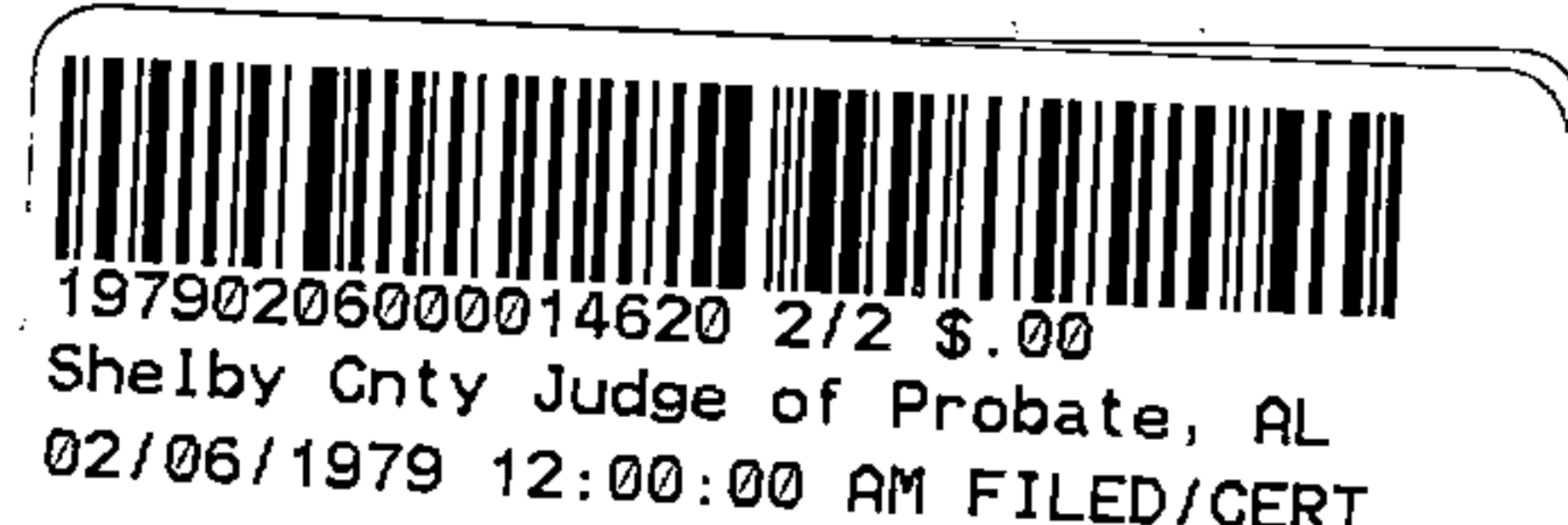

A portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 31, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, described as follows: Begin at the S. W. corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, Township 21 South, Range 2 West and run Northerly along the West side of said quarter-quarter for 255.39 feet; then turn an angle of 90 deg. 00 min. to the right and run Easterly for 129.79 feet; then turn an angle of 90 deg. 00 min. to the right and run Southerly for 329.15 feet to a point on the North right of way of Shelby County Rd. #12; then turn an angle of 89 deg. 51 min. 15 sec. to the right and run Westerly for 131.64 feet to a point on the north R.O.W. of said road; then turn an angle of 91 deg. 34 min. 16 sec. to the right and run Northerly for 74.11 feet back to the point of beginning.
