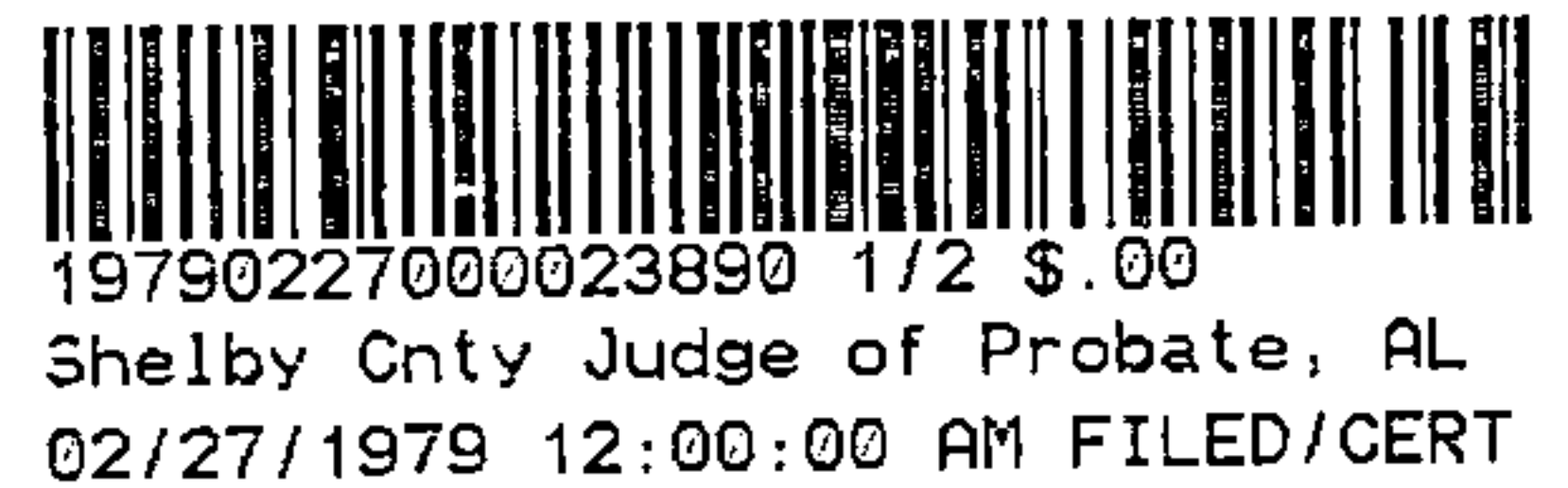

Before me, a Notary Public in and for said County and State, personally appeared Sam E. Kidd, who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Sam E. Kidd. I am 67 years of age and I am a resident of Shelby County, Alabama, my residence address being at Rte 1, Box 155  
Vincent, Ala. I have been a resident of Shelby County, Alabama, for the past 47 years.

I knew Wade H. Jones during his lifetime and also knew the members of his family quite well. Said Wade H. Jones died in 1923, leaving as his sole surviving heirs at law and next of kin his widow, Flora T. Jones and three children, namely, Dr. Wade A. Jones, Etta R. Chamberlain, and Ada J. Hundley, all of whom are now deceased; said Wade H. Jones was not survived by any other children or descendants of deceased children.

Neither said Wade A. Jones, Etta R. Chamberlain, nor Ada J. Hundley had any children born of them. Said Dr. Wade A. Jones died about 1965, and I served as one of the Co-Executors of his Estate.

Said Ada J. Hundley was a "Jones", of course, before she married her husband, Charles Hundley, and she later became a "Jones" again, after the death of her said husband, Charles Hundley. She married again after the death of said Charles Hundley, her last husband having been "A. J. Jones" or "Asbury Jones". Said Etta R. Chamberlain predeceased her brother, Dr. Wade A. Jones, and her sister, said Ada Jones, and since said Etta R. Chamberlain had no children, said Wade A. Jones and said Ada Jones were her sole next of kin, her father having died as aforesaid, and her mother, Flora T. Jones, also having died.

It has been called to my attention that Albert Kidd and wife, Mary Kidd, executed a mortgage in 1929 covering the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 19, Range 3 East, together with other property, but said description in said mortgage was undoubtedly a typographical error, as said Albert Kidd and wife, Mary Kidd, did not own any property in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the South Half of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 18, Township 19, Range 3 East at that time, said property having then been the property of the family of said Wade H. Jones, as aforesaid. Said Albert Kidd was related to me, he being my uncle

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and to my personal knowledge, neither he nor his wife, Mary Kidd, ever claimed or possessed said property or any part thereof.
