JUDGMENT OF DIVORCE

This cause coming on to be heard, was submitted to the Court upon the Complaint of the Plaintiff, Answer of the Defendant, and testimony of the parties in open court, and the Court is of the opinion that the Plaintiff is entitled to the following relief requested in her Complaint,

1. That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between Jacquelyn Elaine Thomas and Raymond A. Thomas, Jr., be and the same are hereby dissolved, and the said Plaintiff is forever divorced from the said Defendant for and on account of incompatibility;

2. That both the Plaintiff and Defendant may again contract marriage as provided by the law of this State; but not until sixty (60) days after the date of this Judgment of Divorce, except to each other; and should this Judgment be appealed from within forty-two (42) days, the privilege hereby accorded to Jacquelyn Elaine Thomas and Raymond A. Thomas, Jr., to contract marriage shall be held and remain in abeyance and abiding the result of such appeal, there being no restrictions or prohibitions of remarriage of the parties herein to each other;

3. That Jacquelyn Elaine Thomas shall have the custody and control of the minor child of the parties, namely, Brandie Sha Thomas;

4. That Raymond A. Thomas, Jr., shall have the right to have said minor child visit with him on the first and third weekends of each month from five o'clock on Friday afternoon until three o'clock on Sunday afternoon;

5. That Raymond A. Thomas, Jr. shall pay to Jacquelyn Elaine Thomas, for the support and maintenance of the minor child of the parties the sum of One Hundred Sixty and 00/100 (\$160.00) Dollars per month, the first payment being due on January 1, 1979 and the payments being due on the first day of each month thereafter; and these payments shall be made to the register of the Circuit Court of Talladega County, Alabama;

6. That Raymond A. Thomas, Jr., shall also keep in full force and effect a hospitalization insurance policy on the minor child of the parties;

7. That Jacquelyn Elaine Thomas shall have the exclusive use and ownership of the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

From the SW corner of Sec 27, T 19S, Range 2E, proceed east along the South boundary of said section a distance of 182.30 feet to the point of beginning: thence continue in a straight line 150.07 feet; thence left 113° 51' a distance of 395.01 feet to a point on the South R.O.W. line of Glaze Ferry Road; thence left 90° 00' along said R.O.W. a distance of 125.00 feet; thence, left 87° 53' a distance of 334.55 feet to the point of beginning, such described property containing 1.02 acres and being all situated in the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 2 East, located in Shelby County, Alabama.

And all of the right, title, and interest of Raymond A. Thomas, Jr. in and to said property is hereby divested out of him and vested in Jacquelyn Elaine Thomas.

8. That Raymond A. Thomas, Jr. shall retain the exclusive use and ownership of the one-half acre lot on which the home of the parties was previously located prior to its burning;

9. That Raymond A. Thomas, Jr. shall pay to the law firm of Bell, Lang, and Bell the sum of Seven Hundred Eighty-Eight and 00/100 (\$788.00) Dollars for their attorneys fees and for the court costs in this proceeding;

10. That Raymond A. Thomas, Jr. is permanently restrained from going on or about the premises occupied by Jacquelyn Elaine Thomas, except for the purpose of exercising his visitation privileges herein above referred to; and from and after the date of this decree, Raymond A. Thomas, Jr. is not to threaten, harass, or intimidate Jacquelyn Elaine Thomas in any manner or way.

11. That the Court retains jurisdiction of the parties to this cause and of said minor child for any further Orders the Court may from time to time deem necessary and proper with respect to the custody and maintenance of said child.
