EASEMENT FOR TRANSMISSION OF ELECTRIC POWER




WITNESSETH:










This grant contains all the terms and conditions of the easement, expressed or implied between the parties hereto and shall be binding upon and enure to the benefit of the GRANTOR, its successors and assigns and the GRANTEE, its successors and assigns.
