Chace and wife, Dorothy Chace to Alabama Power Company dated October 3, 1952 and recorded in Deed Book 156, Page 418 in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama. (Parcel 129501)
- 3. That certain instrument from George W. Chace and wife, Irene R. Chace; B. A. Chace and wife, Ruth B. Chace, and F. A. Chace and wife Dorothy A. Chace to Alabama Power Company dated January 17, 1961 and recorded in Deed Book 214, Page 626 in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama. (Parcel 193024)
