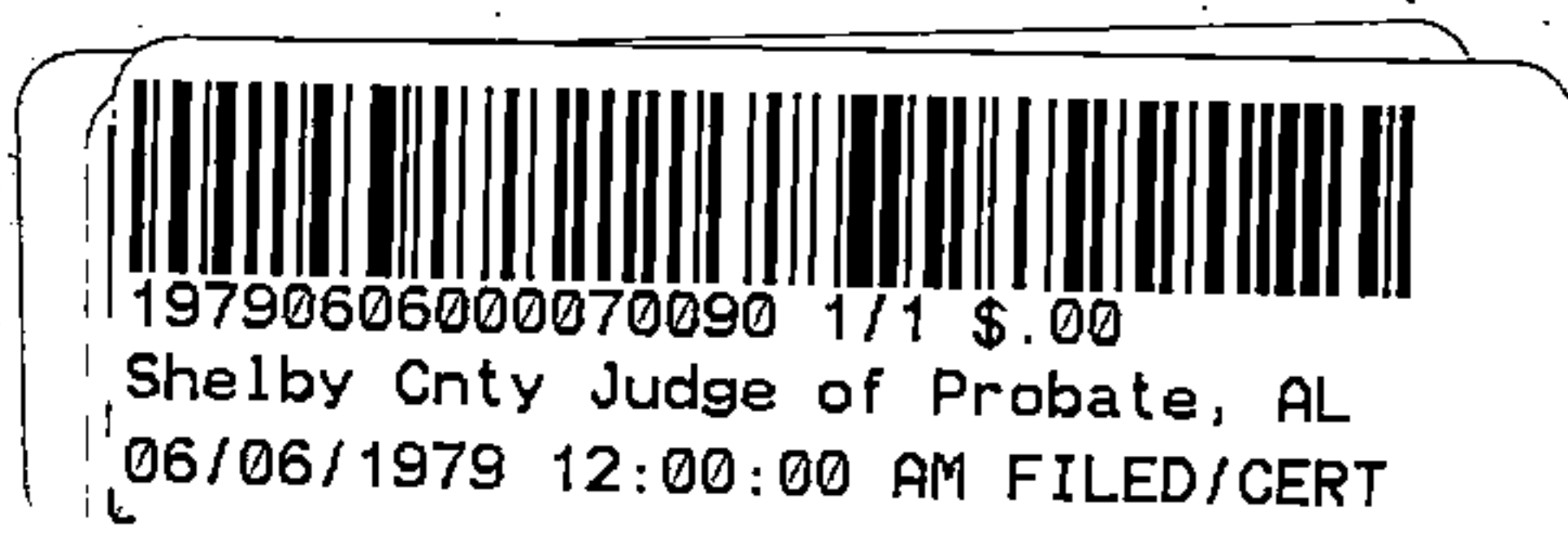


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TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that Alabama Power Company neither claims the right to nor proposes to construct any future lines for the transmission of electricity over or across the lands described herein below, under the authority granted in the following right of way permits:

1. That certain instrument from George W. Chace and wife Irene R. Chace, Bryan A. Chace and wife Ruth B. Chace, and F. A. Chace and wife, Dorothy A. Chace to Alabama Power Company dated July 30, 1948 and recorded in Deed Book 134, Page 427 in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama. (Parcel # 96263)
 2. That certain instrument from G. W. Young and wife, Mary Cooper Young to Alabama Power Company dated April 4, 1945 and recorded in Deed Book 124, Page 535 in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama. (Parcel # 63537)

The purpose for which such right of way permits were acquired was for distribution lines that have heretofore been removed from the property described below:

The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26 all in Township 19 South, Range 3 West, and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 9 South, Range 2 West.
