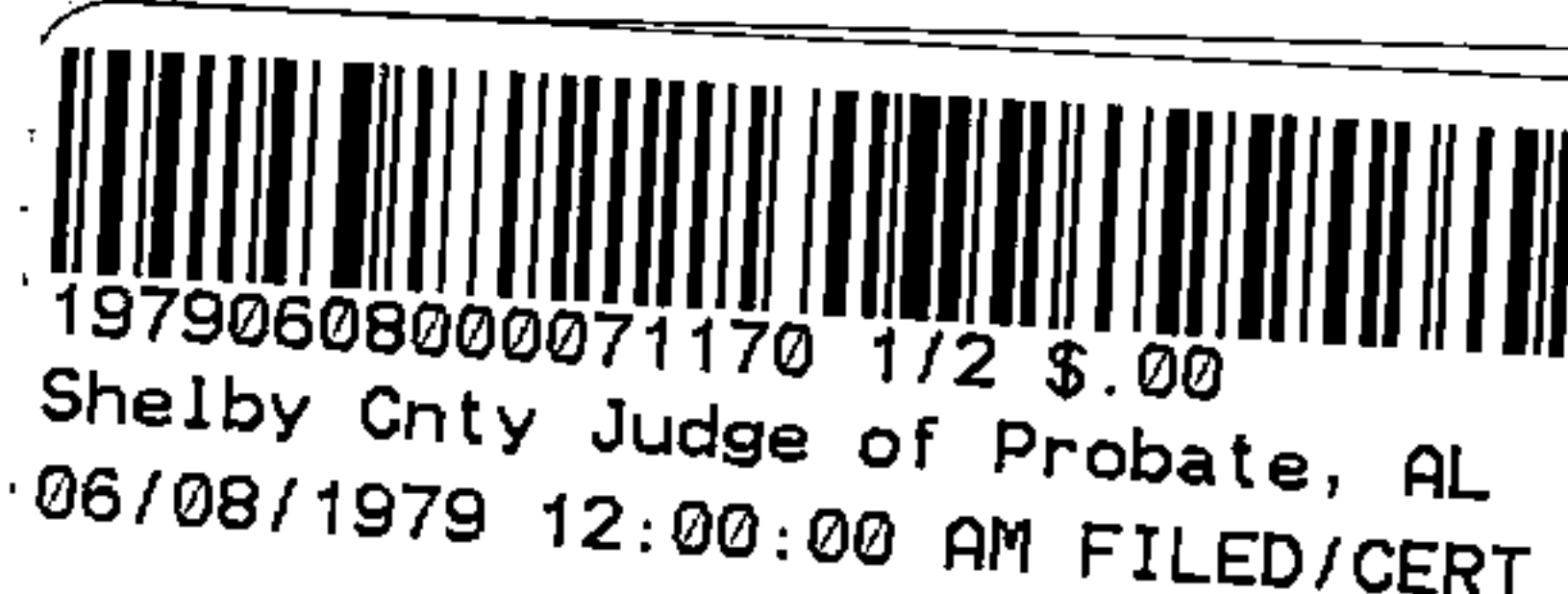

PARCEL I:

Part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama, said part being more particularly described as follows: From the SW corner of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, run east along the south line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$ section for a distance of 203.64 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue east along last mentioned course for a distance of 113.46 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 72° 35' and run in a northeasterly direction for a distance of 32.00 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 90° 00' and run in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 102.00 feet to a point on the south line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$ section; thence turn an angle to the left of 17° 25' and run east along the south line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$ section for a distance of 133.22 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 59° 00' and run in a northeasterly direction for a distance of 385.00 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 90° 00' and run in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 120.00 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 90° and run in a southwesterly direction for a distance of 240.00 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 90° 00' and run in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 203.20 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 115° 00' and run in a southwesterly direction for a distance of 25.66 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 90° 00' and run in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 120.00 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of Lot 4, Block 4, Nicherson-Scott Survey, a map of which is recorded in Map Book 3, Page 34, in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama; thence turn an angle to the left of 90° 00' and run in a southwesterly direction along the east line of Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, Block 4, and it's extension thereof of said Nicherson-Scott Survey for a distance of 279.30 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; containing 2.728 acres, more or less.
