

IT IS SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED that the pipeline herein authorized shall be installed as shown on the Grantee's Drawing No. 2.405.1A dated 4/12/79 titled "Proposed 16-inch Colonial Pipeline Crossing Property of Plantation Pipe Line Company, Shelby County, Alabama LOC.405 AFE 2333" and Grantee's Drawing No. 1.405.1.1 dated 3/11/79 titled "Proposed 16-inch OD Pipeline Crossing Plantation Pipelines Shelby County, Alabama LOC No. 405 AFE 2333", copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference. The following is a centerline description of subject easement in Sections 14 and 15, T2OS, R3W, Shelby County, Alabama.

Commence at the southeast corner of Section 15; thence run N-01°-42'-00"W along the east line of said section a distance of 880.70 feet to a point on the north line of tract of land leased or to be leased to Colonial Pipeline Company; thence N-75°-19'-30"E along said line a distance of 61.66 feet to the point of beginning of centerline description of easement herein described; thence run N-12°-58'-00"W a distance of 307 feet to a point; thence run N-01°-42'-00"W a distance of 126 feet to a point on Plantation's north property line; said point being 15 feet west of the northeast corner of southeast 1/4 of southeast 1/4, Section 15, T20S, k3W and the end of centerline description for installation of a 16-inch pipeline on Plantation's property.

The herein described easement is subject to all encumbrances and easements of record, including, without limiting the foregoing, the three

Plantation pipelines presently crossing this easement area (one 12-inch, one 18-inch and one 30-inch). Plantation, its successors and assigns reserves the right to cross the pipeline herein authorized with streets, roadways, pipelines, (to permit other companies to cross with additional pipelines), railroad tracks, and other facilities in the development of the property by Plantation or its successors and assigns. Grantee, at its expense, agrees to install casing, and raise or lower its pipeline or relocate as may be necessary in order to accommodate the said development.

Grantee shall investigate, defend, indemnify, and hold Plantation, its officers, employees, agents, servants, and representatives, harmless from all claims, loss, liability, attorney's fees, cost and expense, including death, personal injury, and property damage occurring to Lessee or its contractor, or its subcontractors, or Plantation, their respective officers, employees, agents, servants, and representatives or to third parties which arise out of or in connection with, or by reason of the installation, maintenance, operation, repair, replacement, and/or removal or the existence of Grantee's pipeline thereafter, including those claims which are alledged to have been caused from Plantation's sole or concurrent negligence but which arise out of, or in connection with, or by reason of, the installation, maintenance, operation, repair, replacement, and/or removal or the existence of said pipeline thereafter.

Plantation shall have the right to use and enjoy the above-described land except as the same may be necessary for the purposes herein granted to Grantee.

In addition to the above consideration, Grantee agrees to repair or to pay for any damage caused by Grantee exercising any rights herein granted.

The rights herein granted may not be assigned in whole or in part without the written consent of Plantation.

and assigns, so long as this easement and servitude is used, operated and maintained for the purposes aforesaid, provided this indenture shall terminate and said easement and right of way shall be extinguished ipso facto, upon abandonment, for failure to use for a period of six (6) consecutive months or removal of said pipeline by Grantee or its designees, whichever occurs sooner.
