This is to confirm my agreement that I hereby grant to you the privilege to use that part of the lake which I propose building on my property and which will flood approximately 3-1/2 acres on your property for the purpose of swimming, bathing and fishing in that part of the lake on the approximate 3-1/2 acres leased by you to me under a ninety-nine year lease. Provided, however, that your use of this part of the lake for swimming, bathing and fishing will not jeopardize or interfere with the proper maintenance and upheep of the said lake and that no boats of any kind will be allowed on the said lake.

This privilege is granted to you and the members of your family but is not transferable to any other person or persons. However, I do agree that I will grant similar privileges to any persons who may buy and build homes on the two lots which you own which will be contiguous to the lake and front on the public road as it presently exists, if, as and when you should sell such lots and such persons occupy said lots as their home.

It is understood that I am under no obligation to maintain the water level and that I am only responsible for the maintenance of the lake floor itself. However, you will maintain and use the shore or approaches to the lake as you see fit provided it does not interfere with the operation and maintenance of the lake itself. It is also understood that you will assume the responsibility for any person or persons, either yourself or members of your immediate family, who use this lake for the purpose of swimming, bathing or fishing and that I will not be liable for any injury or damages to any person or persons as the result of the use of this portion of the lake as set out herein.
