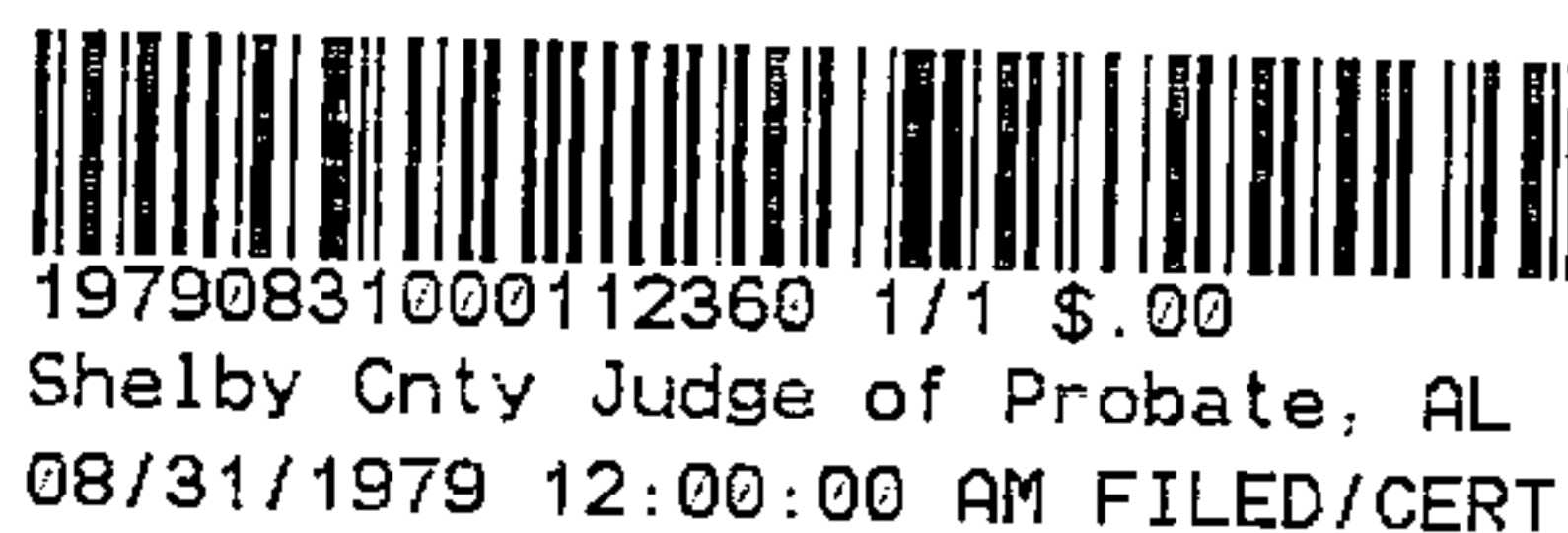


ASSIGNMENT OF MORTGAGE
