

AMENDMENT TO RESTRICTIONS FOR PARK FOREST SUBDIVISION FIRST SECTOR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that:

WHEREAS: (a) BELANDCO, INCORPORATED, an Alabama
Corporation (sometimes referred to herein as "Owner" or
"Developer"), is the Owner and Developer of certain lots
and tracts of land known as Park Forest Subdivision, the
First Sector of which is recorded in Map Book 7, Page 155,
in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County,
Alabama; and

- (b) Developer filed for record Restrictions for Park Forest Subdivision First Sector in Miscellaneous Book 31, Page 788, in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, (herein referred to as "Park Forest Subdivision Restrictive Covenants"); and
- (c) Developer desires to amend said Park Forest Subdivision Restrictive Covenants in the manner as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, Developer does hereby proclaim,
publish and declare that the Park Forest Subdivision Restrictive
Covenants are amended as set forth herein:

- 1. Park Forest Subdivision Restrictive Covenants are hereby amended to add Paragraph 28 thereto which shall read as follows:
 - 28. PARK FOREST SWIM AND TENNIS CLUB, INC.:

 (a) The Developer has organized "Park

 Forest Swim and Tennis Club, Inc.", an Alabama
 non-profit corporation (herein referred to as
 the "Corporation" or "Club"), the original

 Articles of Incorporation for which are recorded
 Corporation Book /9, Page 347, in the
 Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County,
 Alabama, and conveyed to it 3.15 acres, more or
 less, containing the recreational facilities
 and amenities, including swimming pool, cabanna,
 tennis courts, playground area, parking area
 and buffer zones, located within Park Forest
 Subdivision. The deed whereby the Developer

conveyed the 3.15 acres containing such recreational facilities and amenities to the non-profit Corporation free of liens and encumbrances is recorded in Deed Book 322, Page 5/0, in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

- Park Forest Swim and Tennis Club, Inc. was organized to establish, maintain and operate a social and recreational Club not for profit for the mutual advantages to be derived therefrom to the owners of lots within Park Forest Subdivision and its future phases, sectors and additions, who apply for and meet the financial requirements for membership therein as specified in the By-Laws in connection with the use of the recreational facilities contained within the 3.15 acres, more or less, which were conveyed by the Developer to the Club. No person, other than the Developer or its designees, who does not own property in Park Forest Subdivision shall be entitled to become a member of the Club or to the use of its facilities except as a quest of a member.
- (c) The Developer has retained the right to name the Directors of the Club until June 1, 1985, or until the Developer decides to terminate its control over the Club, whichever shall first occur. After such termination of control over the Club by the Developer, the Developer shall have no vote on any matter with respect to the Club. The fees, dues and charges required to be paid by members of the Club as prescribed in the By-Laws, shall not apply to the Developer or its designees prior to termination of control over the Club by the Developer.
- 2. Except as expressly amended hereby to add Paragraph 28, entitled "Park Forest Swim and Tennis Club, Inc.", all provisions of the Park Forest Subdivision Restrictive Covenants shall remain in full force and effect, and the modifications made hereby shall be incorporated into said Park Forest Subdivision Restrictive Covenants with full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Belandco, Incorporated, an Alabama corporation, has caused this Amendment to Restrictions for Park Forest Subdivision First Sector to be properly executed by Belandco, Incorporated, by its duly-authorized officer and recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.
