4. The names, relationships, ages, conditions, and residences of the widow, heirs, and distributees of said decedent's estate are as follows:







ORDER GRANTING LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION

That the death of the intestate has been known more than five days; and that petitioner is the widow of said deceased; and praying that Letters of Administration may be granted to her upon her entering into bond in such sum and with such securities as are required by law; and said petitioner having filed bond as such Administrat rix in the sum of Thirty Thousand And No/100-----(\$30,000.00) Dollars, with United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company as security thereon, payable and conditioned as the law directs, and approved by the Judge of this Court.




