PETITION FOR LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION

TO THE HONORABLE J. PAUL WEEKS, JUDGE OF PROBATE OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, ALABAMA:

Comes your petitioner, Patricia G. Duncan, and, upon information and belief, respectfully shows unto your Honor the following facts:

1. Noel C. Duncan died in Jefferson County, State of Alabama, on or about August 28, 1977, and at the time of such death was an inhabitant of Jefferson County, Alabama.

2. Said death has been known for more than five days; and said decedent left no last will and testament.

3. Said decedent left assets in Jefferson County, Alabama. All of the properties, real and personal, of which said decedent died seized and possessed are estimated to be worth approximately \$15,000.00, and probably not more.

Dollars, with Unites States Fidelity and Guaranty Company

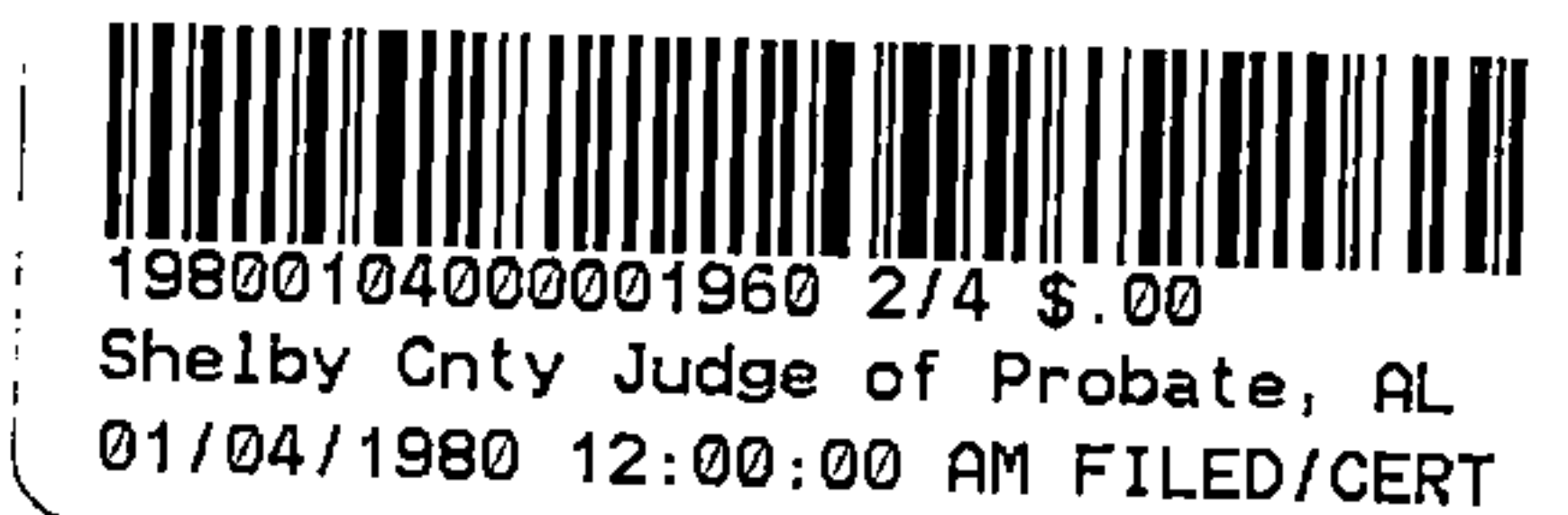
as security thereon, payable and conditioned as the law directs, and approved by the Judge of this Court.

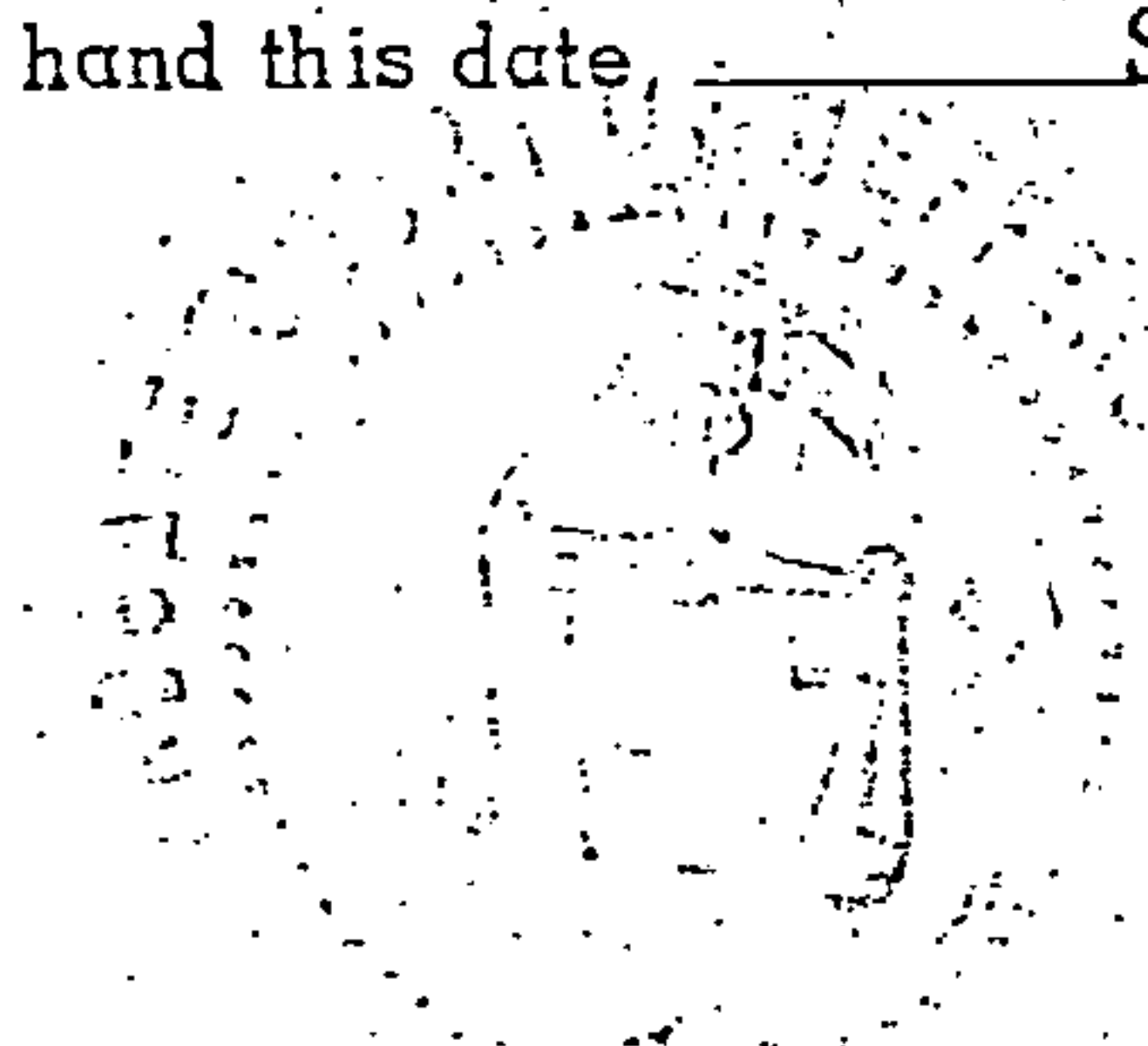
