5- All the rest and residue of my estate of every kind, real, personal and mixed which I may own or possess at the time of my death, in any manner at the time of my death, I give, devise and bequeath to my wife, Exie R. Lee, to be held and owned by her absolutely and without condition.

6- I appoint my wife, Exie R. Lee, as executrix of this will and exempt her from giving bond as such executrix; I also exempt her from filing an inventory of my estate to the probate court in any court. 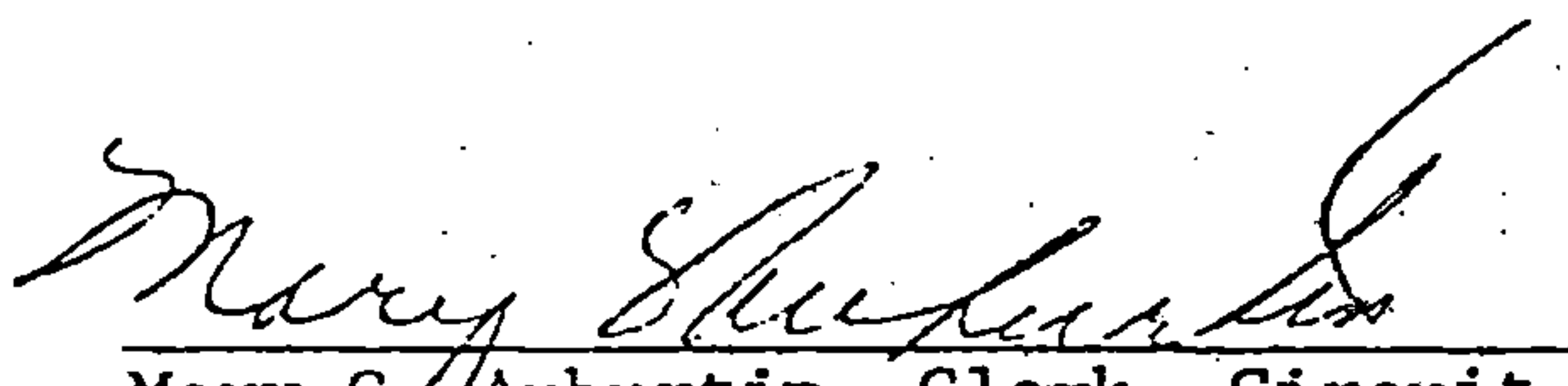
