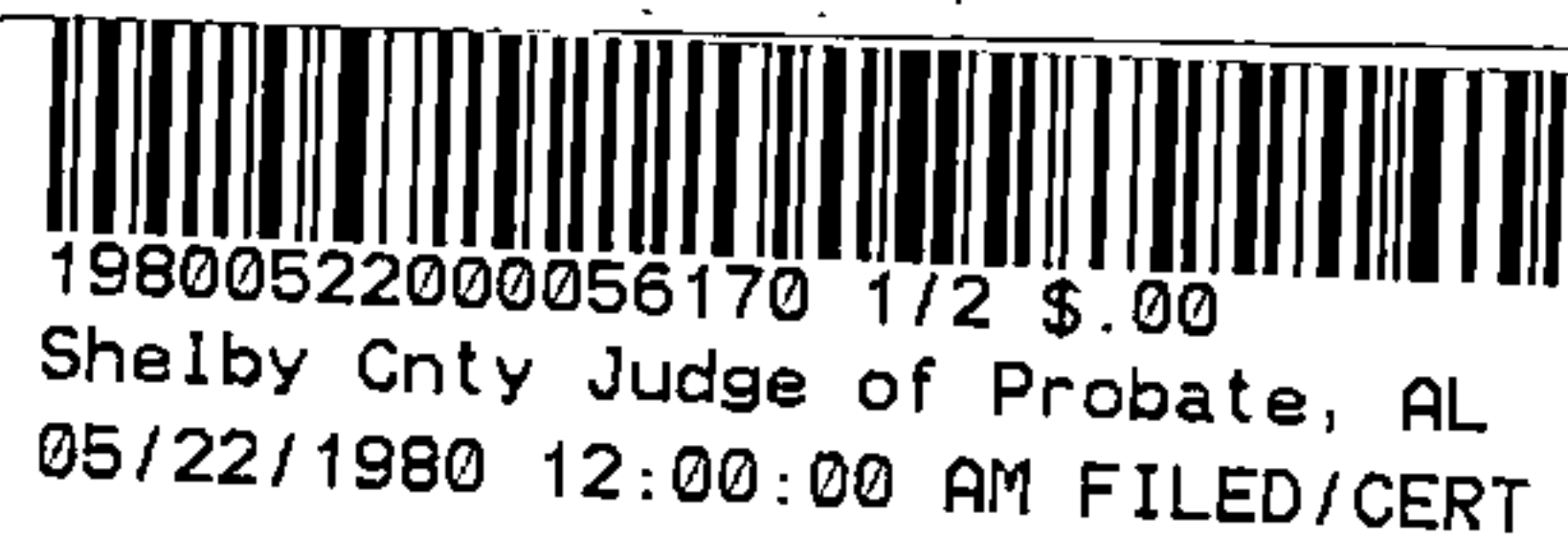

Comes now Thomas A. Snowden, Jr. who being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

My name is Thomas A. Snowden, Jr., I am over the age of twenty-one years and am a resident citizen of Shelby County, Alabama. I am the Chairman of the Shelby County Commission. I have diligently searched the records of the Shelby County Commission and I do not find any hearing, petition or notice being issued for the closing or vacating of the following described section of highway:

All of the right of way of Old U. S. Highway 280 lying in the S/W 1/4 of the S/W 1/4, Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 2 West, between the west line of the said Section 32 and a line 60 feet west of and parallel to the center line of existing Highway 119.

To my knowledge as Chairman of the Shelby County Commission, there has been no closing or vacating of the said section of highway as above described.

Further, I have diligently searched the records of the Shelby County Commission and do not find any petition filed by the Shelby County Commission with the Probate Court of Shelby County for the closing or vacating of the said described highway. To my knowledge as Chairman of the Shelby County Commission, no such petition has ever been filed and further, there has been no closing or vacating of the said section of highway.

Further, after diligent search I do not find any resolution by the Shelby County Commission assenting to closing or vacating of the said described highway by the owner or owners of land abutting the said highway.

This affidavit is filed in support of a Motion for Summary Judgment filed in the case of Joe A. Scotch, Jr. et al v. R. Hugh Daniel, Sr., et al, pending in the Circuit Court of Shelby County.

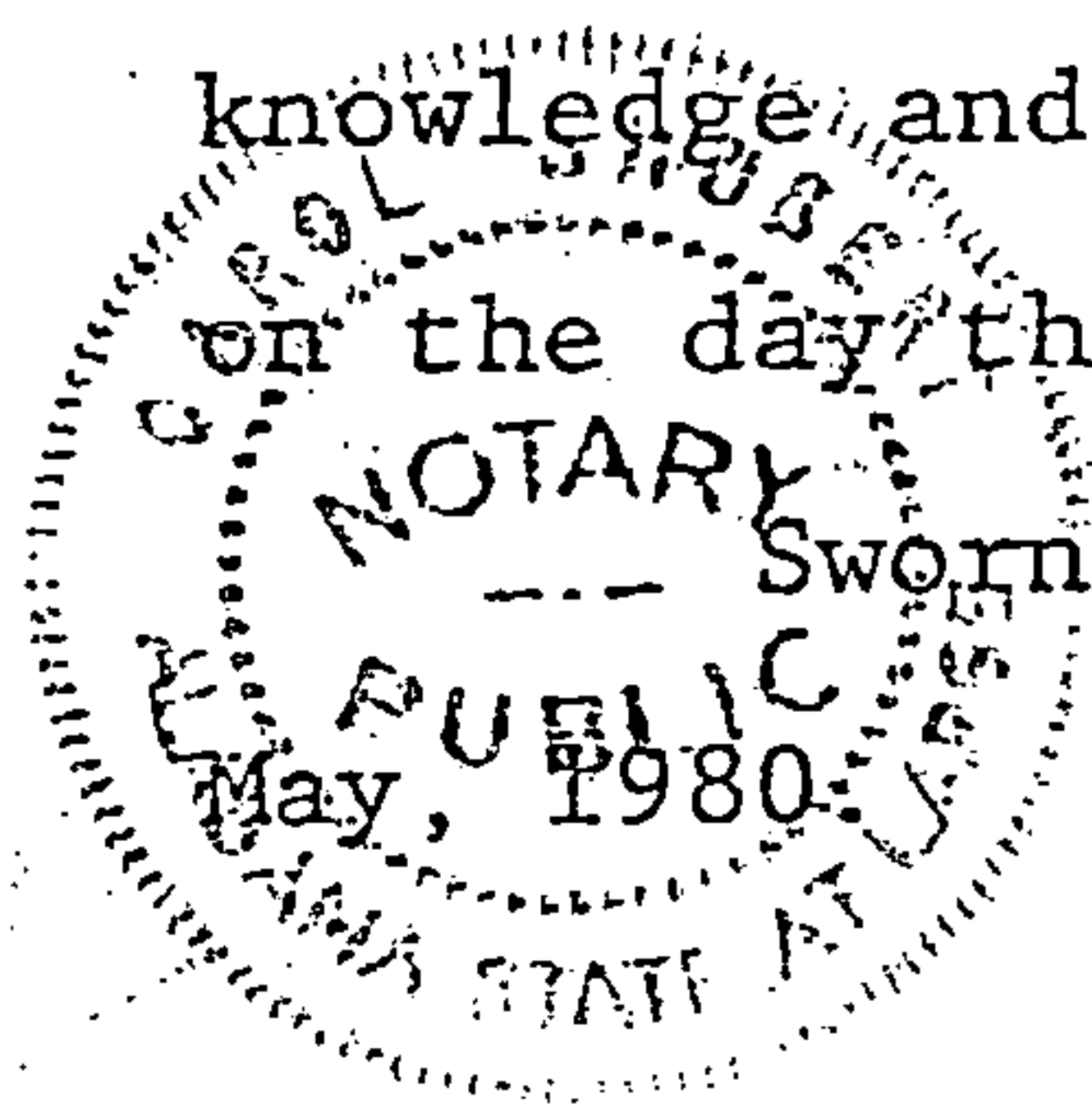

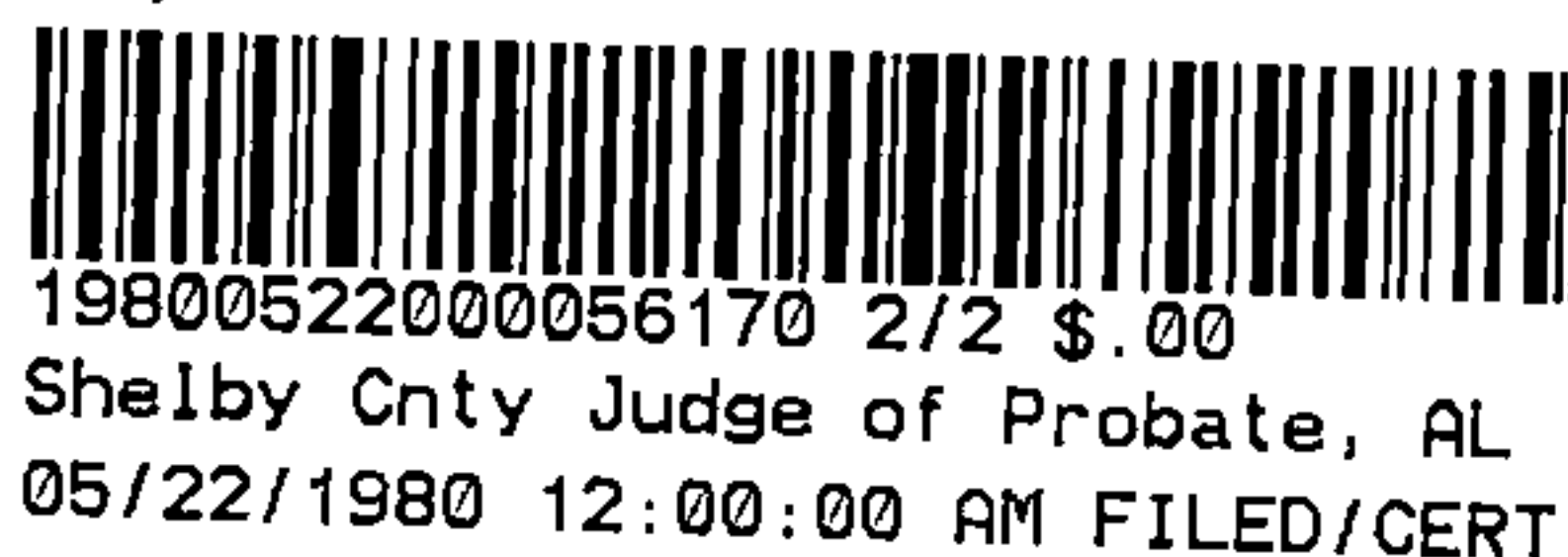
