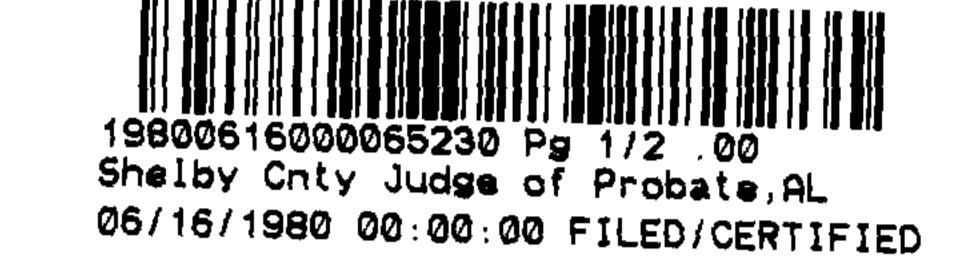
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HOS OIL, GAS AND MINERAL LEASE

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exclusively unto Lessee for the purpose of investigating, exploring, prospecting, drilling and mining for and producing oil, gas and all other minerals, lapipe lines, building roads, tanks, power stations, telephone lines and other structures thereon to produce, save, take care of, treat, transport and own
products, and housing its employees, the following described land inCounty, Alabama, toCounty,

Township 20 South, Range 2 Bast

Section 17: Si of SEM; NEW of SEM.



It is agreed and understood by and between the parties hereto that this lease does not cover nor include coal, iron ore, or other minerals mined by the open pit or shall methods

It is the intention of Lessor and Lessee that this lease shall also include, and there is hereby included, granted, leased and let, for the purposes and consideration berein stated, all the land owned or claimed by Lessor, adjacent or contiguous to the land particularly described above, whether the same be in said section or section grant or grants, or in adjacent sections or grants, although not included within the boundaries of the land particularly described above. For the purpose of determining

the amount of any money payment hereunder, the lands herein described shall be treated as comprising _______________acres, whether there be more or less, and in the event of a partial assignment or surrender hereunder, the assigned or surrendered portion or portions shall be deemed to contain the number of acres stated in such assignment or surrender.

2. Subject to the other provisions herein contained, this lease shall be for a term of ten years from this date (called "primary term") and as lon thereafter as oil, gas or other mineral is produced from said land or lands with which said land is pooled hereunder.

3. The royalties to be paid by Lessee are: (a) on oil, one-eighth (1/8) of that produced and saved from said land, the same to be delivered at the wells of to the credit of Lessor into the pipeline to which the wells may be connected; Lessee may from time to time purchase any royalty oil in its possession, paying th marker price therefor prevailing for the field where produced on the date of purchase, in either case such interest to bear its proportion of any expense of treat ing unmerchantable oil to render it merchantable as crude; (b) on gas, one-eighth (1/8) of the market value at the well of the gas used by Lesser in operations no connected with the land leased or any pooled unit containing all or a part of said land; the royalty on gas sold by Lessee to be one-excited (1/8) of the amoun realized at the well from such sales: (c) one-eighth (1/8) of the market value at the mouth of the well of gas used by Lessee in manufacturing gasoline of other hy-products, except that in computing such value, there shall be excluded all gas or components thereof used in lease or unit operations; and (d) or all other minerals mined and marketed, one-tenth (1/10) either in kind or value at the well or mine, at Lessee's election, except that on sulphur mined an marketed, the royalty shall be fifty cents (50c) per long ton. In the event that any well on the land or on property pooled therewith (or with any part thereof is capable of producing oil or gas or gaseous substances in paying quantities but such minerals are not being produced, then Lessee's rights may be maintained, in the absence of production or drilling operations, by commencing or resuming rental payments (herein sometimes referred to as shut in gas payments) as herein after provided in paragraph 6. Should such conditions occur or exist at the end of or after the primary term, or within sixty (60) days prior to the expiration there of, Lessee's rights may be extended beyond and after the primary term by the commencement, resumption or continuance of such payments at the rule and in th manner herein provided for restal payments during the primary term, and for the purpose of computing and making such payments the expiration date of th primary term and each anniversary date thereof shall be considered as a fixed rental paying date, and if such payments are made, it will be considered that o or gas or gaseous substance is being produced within the meaning of paragraph 2 hereof. Lessee shall have free use of oil, gas, wood, and water from sai land, except water from Lessor's wells, for all operations hereunder, and royalty on oil, gas and coak-shall be computed after deducting any so used.

4. Lessee, at its option, is bereby given the right and power to pool or combine the acreage covered by this lease or any portion thereof with othe land, lease or leases in the immediate vicinity thereof, when in Lessee's judgment it is necessary or advisable to do so in order properly to develop and operate said premises in compliance with any lawful spacing rules which may be prescribed for the field in which this lease is situated by any duly authorize authority, or when to do so would, in the judgment of Lessee, promote the conservation of the oil and gas in and under and that may be produced from said premises. Lessee shall execute in writing an instrument identifying and describing the pooled acreage. The entire acreage so pooled into a tract or unshall be treated, for all purposes except the payment of royalties on production from the pooled unit, as if it were included in this lease. If production is foun on the pooled acreage, it shall be treated as if production is had from this lease, whether the well or wells be located on the premises covered by this lease on not. In lieu of the royalties except herein specified, Lessor shall receive on production from a unit so pooled only such portion of the royalty stipulate herein as the amount of his acreage placed in the unit or his royalty interest therein on an acreage basis bears to the total acreage so pooled in the particula unit involved.

5. If operations for drilling are not commenced on said land or on acreage pooled therewith as above provided on or before one year from this date the lease shall then terminate as to both parties, unless on or before such anniversary date Lessee shall pay or tender to Lessor or to the credit of Lesson in 1185 Alabama Danie, Five Points So. Snanc h Bank at Dinningham Alabam (which bank and its successors are Lessor's agent and shall continue as the depository for all rentals payable hereunder regardless of changes in ownership

of said land or the rentals) the sum of One Hundred Twenty and 40/100 Dolla

6. If prior to discovery of oil, gas or other mineral on said land or on acreage pooled therewith Lessee should drill a dry hole or holes thereon, or after discovery of oil, gas or other mineral, the production thereof should cease from any cause, this lease shall not terminate if Lessee commences addition or reworking operations within 60 days thereafter or if it be within the primary term, commences or resumes the payment or tender of realists or commences operations for drilling or reworking on or before the rental paying date next ensuing after the expiration of 60 days from date of completion of drilling or reworking on or before the rental paying date next ensuing after the expiration of the primary term and prior to the discovery of oil, gas or other mineral on said land, or on acreage pooled therewith. Lessee should drill a dry hole thereon, no rental payment or operations an necessary in order to keep the lease in force during the remainder of the primary term. If at the expiration of the primary term, oil, gas or other mineral completed a dry hole thereon within sixty (60) days prior to the end of the primary term. If at the expiration of the primary term, oil, gas or other mineral is produced on said land, or on acreage pooled therewith, but Lessee is then engaged in drilling or reworking operations thereon or shall have completed a dry hole thereon within sixty (60) days prior to the end of the primary term, the lease shall remain in force so long as operations are prosecuted with no cessation of more than sixty (60) consecutive days, and if they result in the production of oil, gas or other mineral, so long thereafter as oil, go or other mineral is produced from said land or acreage pooled therewith. In the event a well or wells producing oil or gas in paying quantities should be brought in on adjacent land and within one hundred fifty (150) feet of and draining the leased premises, or acreage pooled therewith, Lessee agrees a drill such offset wells as a reasonably prudent operator would drill und

7. Lessee shall have the right at any time during or after the expiration of this lease to remove all property and fixtures placed by Lessee on sail land, including the right to draw and remove all casing. When required by Lessor, Lessee will bury all pipe lines below ordinary plow depth, and no we shall be drilled within two hundred (200) feet of any residence or barn now on said land without Lessor's consent. Lessee shall be responsible for a damages caused by Lessee's operations hereunder other than damages necessarily caused by the exercise of the rights herein granted.

8. The rights of either party hereunder may be assigned in whole or in part, and the provisions hereof shall extend to their heirs, successors an assigns: but no change or division in ownership of the land, rentals or royalties, however accomplished, shall operate to enlarge the obligations or diminis the rights of Lessee; and no change or division in such ownership shall be hinding on Lessee until thirty (30) days after Lessee shall have been furnished by registered U. S. mail at Lessee's principal place of business with a certified copy of recorded instrument or instruments evidencing same. In the event of assignment hereof in whole or in part liability for breach of any obligation hereunder shall rest exclusively upon the owner of this lease or of a portion there of who commits such breach. In the event of the death of any person entitled to rentals hereunder. Lessee may pay or tender such rentals to the credit of the deceased or the estate of the deceased until such time as Lessee is furnished with proper evidence of the appointment and qualifications of an executor of administrator of the estate, or if there be none, then until Lessee is furnished with evidence satisfactory to it as to the heirs or devisees of the deceased, an that all debts of the estate have been paid. If at any time two or more persons be entitled to participate in the rental payable hereunder, Lessee may pay or tender said rental jointly to such persons or to their joint credit in the depository named herein; or, at Lessee's election, the proportionate part of said rental to which each participant is entitled may be paid or tendered to him separately or to his separate credit in said depository; and payment or tender to an participant of his portion of the rentals hereunder shall maintain this lease as to such participant. In event of assignment of this lease as to a segregated po tion of said land, the rentals payable hereunder shall be apportionable as between the several leasehold owners ratably according to the surface area of each and default in rental payment by one shall not affect the rights of other leasehold owners hereunder. If six or more parties become entitled to royalty here under. Lessee may withhold payment thereof unless and until furnished with a recordable instrument executed by all such parties designating an agent to receive payment for all.

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9. The breach by Lessee of any obligation bereunder shall in part save as herein expressly provided. If the obligation feelpt of written notices by Lessee from Lessor specifically stated or wells: and the only penalty for failure so to do shall be reducing oil or gas, to be selected by Lessee so that each for paying quantities on said premises, Lessee shall reasonably e required to drill more than one well per forty (40) acrementation. 10.
