KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Richard T. Wyatt,

WHEREAS, the above bounden Richard T. Wyatt, Wilma S. Finn

Wyatt as heir of said Estate, or should make any demand upon said Administrator or file any suit against said Administrator for said distributive share or any portion thereof, then and in either of such events, the undersigned shall refund and pay back to the said Leonard Wyatt, Jr., as Administrator of said Estate, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars, being the balance paid on said distributive share to the undersigned, and the costs of suit, then the above obligation is to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

The undersigned, as part of the consideration hereof do waive all rights of exemption under the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama or any other State of which they may be a resident, against the obligation granted under this refunding bond.
