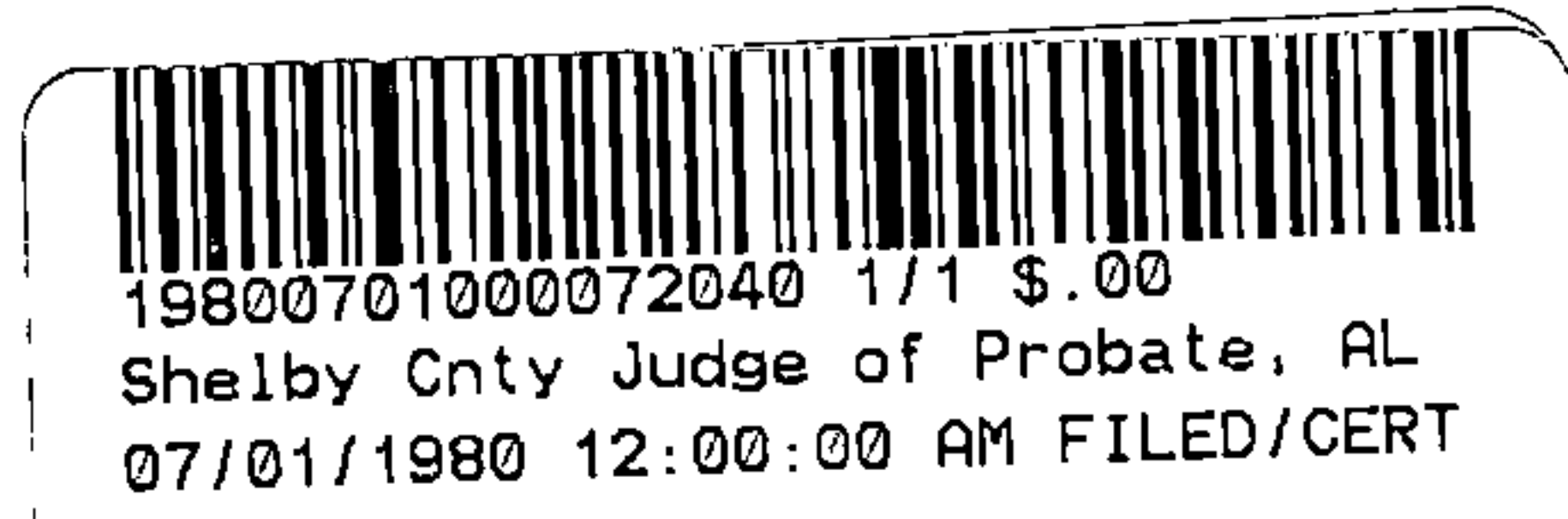

Before me, the undersigned, personally appeared GEORGE W. PORTER, JR., who, being known to me and being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is GEORGE W. PORTER, JR. My wife, Faye Harvey Porter, and I formerly owned the following described land:

Commencing at the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 1 East, the point of beginning; thence North 87 deg. 32' W a distance of 823.25 feet to a point on the South R.O.W. line of Shelby County Road No. 43; thence turn an angle of 125 deg. 34' to the right along said R.O.W. line a distance of 1,369.90 feet to a point; thence turn an angle of 141 deg. 58' to the right for a distance of 1,080.50 feet to the point of beginning. Said land being situated in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 1 East, Shelby County, Alabama.

which said land was sold by us to Jerry Wayne Brown and wife, Jan Brown, by deed dated September 9, 1977 recorded in Deed Book 307, page 706 in the Probate Records of Shelby County, Alabama. In the said deed it was recited that \$15,000 of the purchase price was paid from an unidentified mortgage; the mortgage referred to in said deed was not in favor of me or my said wife, but instead was a mortgage from Mr. and Mrs. Brown to Kathryn and Margery Purdy, which said mortgage was recorded in said Probate Records of Shelby County, Alabama.

It has been called to my attention that a judgment appears of record in said Probate Office in Judgment Book K, page 547 in favor of Van Clothing Co., Inc. against one "George Porter, Jr." I am definitely not the same person against whom said judgment is of record and am not indebted to said judgment creditor in any way.
