t is agreed and understood by and between the parties hereto that this lease does not over nor include coal, iron ore, or other minerals mined by the open pit or shaft methods.

It is the intention of Lessor and Lessee that this lease shall also include, and there is hereby included, granted, leased and let, for the purposes and consideration herein stated, all the land owned or claimed by Lessor, adjacent or contiguous to the land particularly described above, whether the same be in said section or sections, grant or grants, or in adjacent sections or grants, although not included within the boundaries of the land particularly described above. For the purpose of determining

the amount of any money payment hereunder, the lands herein described shall be treated as comprising 522 acres, whether there be more acres stated in such assignment or surrender hereunder, the assigned or surrendered portion or portions shall be deemed to contain the number of acres stated in such assignment or surrender.

2. Subject to the other provisions herein contained, this lease shall be for a term of ten years from this date (called "primary term") and as long thereafter as oil, gas or other mineral is produced from said land or lands with which said land is pooled hereunder.

3. The revelth's to be paid by Lessee are: (a) on oil, one-eighth (1/8) of that produced and saved from said land, the same to be delivered at the wells or to the credit of Lessor into the pipeline to which the wells may be connected; Lessee may from time to time purchase any royalty oil in its possession, paying the market price trenefor prevailing for the field where produced on the date of purchase, in either case such interest to bear its proportion of any expense of treating unmerclantable of the render it merchantable as crude; (b) on gas, one-eighth (1/8) of the market value at the well of the gas used by Lessee in operations not connected with the land leased or any pooled unit containing all or a part of said land; the royalty on gas sold by Lessee to be one-eighth (1/8) of the amount realized at the well from such sales; (c) one-eighth (1/8) of the market value at the mouth of the well of gas used by Lessee in manufacturing gasoline or other by products, except that in corputing such value, there shall be excluded all gas or components thereof used in lease or unit operations; and (d) on all other minerals mined and marketed, one-tenth (1/10) either in kind or value at the well or mine, at Lessee's election, except that on sulphur mined and marketed, the foyalty shall be fifty cents (50c) per long ton. In the event that any well on the land or on property pooled therewith (or with any part thereof) - is capable of producing oil or gas or gaseous substances in paying quantities but such minerals are not being produced, then Lessee's rights may be maintained, in the absence of production or drilling operations, by commencing or resuming rental payments (herein sometimes referred to as shut in gas payments) as hereinafter provided in paragraph 6. Should such conditions occur or exist at the end of or after the primary term, or within sixty (60) days prior to the expiration thereof, Lessee's rigits may be extended beyond and after the primary term by the commencement, resumption or continuance of such payments at the rate and in the manner herein provided for rental payments during the primary term, and for the purpose of computing and making such payments the expiration date of the primary term and each anniversary date thereof shall be considered as a fixed rental paying date, and if such payments are made, it will be considered that oil or gas or gaseous substance is being produced within the meaning of paragraph 2 hereof. Lessee shall have free use of oil, gas, xoux xoux water from said Innd, except water from Lessor's wells, for all operations hereunder, and royalty on oil, gas and kolkshall be computed after deducting any so used.

4. Lessee, at its option, is hereby given the right and power to pool or combine the acreage covered by this lease or any portion thereof with other crate said premises in compliance with any lawful spacing rules which may be prescribed for the field in which this lease is distracted by any duly authorized said premises. Lessee shall execute in writing an instrument identifying and describing the pooled acreage. The entire acreage so pooled into a tract or unit on the pooled acreage, it shall be treated as if production is had from this lease, whether the well or wells be located on the premises covered by this lease or herein as the amount of his acreage placed in the unit or his royalty interest therein on an acreage basis bears to the total acreage so pooled in the particular

5. If operations for drilling are not commenced on said land or on acreage pooled therewith as above provided on or before one year from this date the lease shall then terminate as to both parties, unless on or before such anniversary date Lessee shall pay or tender to Lessor or to the credit of Lessor.

(which bank and its successors are Lessor's agent and shall continue as the depository for all rentals payable hereunder regardless of changes in ownership of said land or the sentals) the sum of Five Hundred Twenty Two and No/100

(\$ 522.00 ), (herein called rental), which shall cover the privilege of deferring commencement of drilling operations for a period of twelve (12) months. In like manner and upon like payments or tenders annually the commencement of drilling operations may be further deferred for successive periods of twelve (12) months each during the primary term. The payment or tender of rental may be made by the check or draft of Lessee mailed other bank, or for any reason fail or refuse to accept rental, Lessee shall not be held in default for failure to make such payment or tender of rental until down cash payment is consideration for this lease according to its terms and shall not be allocated as mere rental for a period. Lessee may at any time scribed premises and deliver to Lessor or to the depository above named or place of record a release covering any portion or portions of the above described premises and thereby surrender this lease as to such portion or portions and be relieved of all obligations as to the acreage surrendered, and there-

after the rentals payable hereunder shall be reduced in the proportion that the acreage covered hereby is reduced by said release or releases.

6. If prior to discovery of oil, gas or other mineral on said land or on acreage pooled therewith Lessee should drill a dry hole or holes thereon, or if drilling or reworking operations within 60 days thereafter or if it be within the primary term, commences or resumes the payment or tender of rentals or commences operations for drilling or reworking on or before the rental paying date next ensuing after the expiration of 60 days from date of completion of dry hole or existion of production. If at any time subsequent to sixty (60) days prior to the beginning of the last year of the primary term and prior to the disnecessary in order to keep the lease in force during the remainder of the primary term. If at the expiration of the primary term, oil, gas or other mineral is not being produced on said land, or on acreage pooled therewith, but Lessee is then engaged in drilling or reworking operations thereon or shall have ed with no cessation of more than sixty (60) days prior to the end of the primary term, the lease shall remain in force so long as operations are prosecutor or other mineral is produced from said land or acreage pooled therewith. In the event a well or wells as a reasonably prudent operator would drill under the same or similar circumstances,

7. Levee shall have the right at any time during or after the expiration of this lease to remove all property and fixtures placed by Lessee on said land, including the right to draw and remove all casing. When required by Lesser, Lessee will bury all pipe lines below ordinary plow depth, and no well damages caused by Lessee's operations hereunder other than damages necessarily caused by the exercise of the rights herein granted.

8. The rights of either party bereunder may be assigned in whole or in part, and the provisions bereof shall extend to their heirs, successors and assigns; but no change or division in ownership of the land, rentals or royalties, however accomplished, shall operate to enlarge the obligations or diminish the rights of Lessee; and no change or division in such owner hip shall be binding on Lessee until thirty (30) days after Lessee shall have been turnished by registered U. S. mail at Lessee's principal place of business with a certified copy of recorded instrument or instruments evidencing same. In the event of savignment bereof in whole or in part liability for breach of any obligation bereunder shall rest exclusively upon the owner of this lease or of a portion theoreth deceased or the estate of the deceased until such time as Lessee is furnished with proper evidence of the appointment and qualifications of an executor or that all debts of the estate, or if there be none, then until Lessee is furnished with proper evidence of the appointment and qualifications of an executor or that all debts of the estate have been paid, it at any time two or more persons be entitled to participate in the rental payable becometr. Lessee may pay or tender said rental jointly to such persons or to their joint credit in the depository named herein; or, at Lessee's election, the proportionate part of said rental participant is entitled may be paid or tendered to him separately or to his separate credit in said depository; and payment or tender to any participant of his portion of the rentals hereunder shall maintain this lease as to such participant. In event of assignment of this lease as to a suggested portion of said land, the rental payable hereunder shall not affect the right of other least hold owners hereunder. If six or more parties become entitled to revally here-reive nearesters and withhold payment thereof unless and until furnished with a recordable instrument executed by all such parties designating an agent to re-
