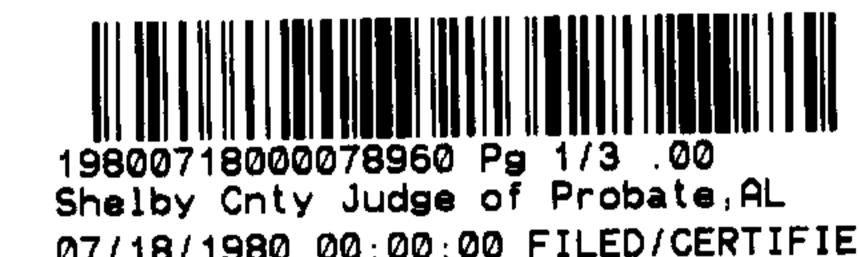

THIS LEASE DOES NOT COVER COAL, IRON ORE, OR OTHER HARD ROCK MINERALS.

It is the intention of Lessor and Lessee that this lease shall also include, and there is hereby included, granted, leased and let, for the purposes and consideration herein stated, all the land owned or claimed by Lessor, adjacent or contiguous to the land particularly described above, whether the same be in said section or sections, grant or grants, or in adjacent sections or grants, although not included within the boundaries of the land particularly described above. For the purpose of determining

the amount of any money payment hereunder, the lands herein described shall be treated as comprising acres, whether there be more or less, and in the event of a partial assignment or surrender, the assigned or surrendered portion or portions shall be deemed to contain the number of acres stated in such assignment or surrender.

2. Subject to the other provisions herein contained, this lease shall be for a term of ten years from this date (called "primary term") and as long theoretter as oil, gas or other mineral is produced from said land or lands with which said land is pooled hereunder.

3. The royaldes to be paid by Lessee are: (a) on oil, one-eighth (1/8) of that produced and saved from said land, the same to be deliced a the wells or to the credit of Lessor into the pipeline to which the wells may be connected: Lessee may from time to time purchase any royalty oil in its process as paying the n where price therefor proveding for the field where produced on the date of purchase, in either case such interest to bear its proportion of any expense of treating ugmerchantible oil to zender it merchantable as crude; (b) on gas, one-eighth (1/8) of the market value at the well of the gas used by Lessie in operations not consected with the land leased or any pooled unit containing all or a part of said land; the royalty on gas sold by Lessee to be one-existed it, 3000 the amount realized at the well from such sales; (c) one-eighth (1/8) of the market value at the mouth of the well of gas used by Lessee in manufactorial gasoline or other by-pioducts, telept-that in computing such value, there shall be excluded all gas or components thereof used in lease or unit operations, and (d) on all sther minerals lamed had marketed, one-tenth (1/10) either in kind or value at the well or mine, at Lessee's election, except that on salphar mined and marketed, the royetty shall be fifty cents (50c) per long ton. In the event that any well on the land or on property pooled therewith (or with any part thereof) is capable of producing oil or gas or gaseous substances in paying quantities but such minerals are not being produced, then Lesce's rights may be an intamed, in the absence of production or drilling operations, by commencing or resuming rental payments (herein sometimes referred to as shut in gas payarmas) as hereinwite presided in paragreph 5. Should such conditions occur or exist at the end of or after the primary term, or within sirty (60) days prior to the expeation thereof, Laste's rights may be extended beyond and after the primary term by the commencement, resumption or continuance of such payments at the case and in the massner becen provided for rental payments during the primary term, and for the purpose of computing and making such payments the experation date of the primary term and each anniversary date thereof shall be considered as a fixed routal paying date, and if such payments are made, it will be considered that oil or gas or caseous substance is being produced within the meaning of paragraph 2 hereof. Lessoe shall have free use of oil, gas, coal, wood and water from said land, except water from Lessor's wells, for all operations hereunder, and royalty on oil, gas and coal shall be compaced after deducting any so assol,

4. Lessee, at its option, is hereby given the right and power to pool or combine the acreage covered by this lease or any portion thereof with other had ince or leases in the immediate vicinity thereof, when in Lessee's judgment it is necessary or advisable to do so in order properly to develop and opcrate said premises in compliance with any lawful spacing rules which may be prescribed for the field in which this lease is situated by any dely authorized authority, or when to do so would, in the judgment of Lessee, promote the conservation of the oil and gas in and under and that may be produced from said premises. Lessee shall execute in writing an instrument identifying and describing the pooled acreage. The entire acreage so pooled into a tract or unit shall be treated, for all parposes except the payment of royalties on production from the pooled unit, as if it were included in this lease. If production is found on the pooled acreage, it shall be treated as if production is had from this lease, whether the well or wells be located on the premises covered by this lease or pot. In her of the royalties elsewhere herein specified, Lessor shall receive on production from a unit so pooled only such portion of the royalty stigntated herein as the amount of his acreage placed in the unit or his royalty interest therein on an acreage basis bears to the total acreage so pooled in the particular

If at any time subsequent to sixty (60) days prior to the beginning of the last year of the primary term and prior to the discovery of oil, gas or other mineral on said land, or on acreage pooled therewith, Lessee should drill a dry hole thereon, no rental payment or operations are necessary in order to keep the lease in force during the remainder of the primary term. If at the expiration of the primary term, oil, gas or other mincral is not being produced on said land, or on acreage pooled therewith, but Lessee is then engaged in drilling or reworking operations thereon or shall have completed a dry hole thereon within sixty (60) days prior to the end of the primary term, the lease shall remain in force so long as operations are prosecut. ed with no cessation of more than sixty (60) consecutive days, and if they result in the production of oil, gas or other mineral, so long thereafter as oil, gas or other mineral is produced from said land or acrease pooled therewith.
