the North West quarter of the South East quarter of the two thirty six, six hundred and eighty eight, of Range One, East, in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing wholly nine acres and thirty four and three hundredths of an acre,

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said

Colvin Bash,
and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
