WITNESSETH:

THAT FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar and
other good and valuable consideration, including an exchange of
lands between the parties hereto this day consummated, to the party
of the first part in hand paid by the party of the second part, the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part
has granted, bargained and sold, and does by these presents grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part the
following described real property, situated in Shelby County,
Alabama, to wit:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying South and West of the centerline
of Yellowleaf Creek; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying North of centerline
of Yellowleaf Creek and West of the first branch, which
branch crosses the north line of Section 7 480 feet due
east of the northwest corner of said Section (being 7 acres
more or less), all in Section 7, T20S, R2E; That part of
the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, T19S, R1E
lying South of U. S. Highway #280, all being in Shelby
County, Alabama.
