Should my sister, Edna Estelle Alexander, be incapacitated at the time of my death, then I give, devise and bequeath my entire estate, both real and personal, mixed or otherwise, wherever located to my niece, Jewell Alexander Carter, for the use and benefit of my sister, Edna Estelle Alexander, as long as she lives, and I direct her to use whatever is necessary for the support and maintenance of my sister, and I give her complete power within her own discretion, to sell any assets I have in order to convert it into money, and to this end, to execute any conveyance that is necessary and receive the proceeds thereof without an accounting to the Court or anyone, and upon the death of my sister, whatever remains, I give, devise and bequeath to my niece, Jewell Alexander Carter, the remainder of my estate to be hers absolutely.

It is my desire, and I request that my sister, Edna Estelle Alexander, take charge of my body at the time of my death, and do everything necessary for my funeral, and should my sister, Edna Estelle Alexander, predecease me or be incapacitated at the time of my death, then I request that her daughter, my niece, Jewell Alexander Carter, take her place and take charge of my body and see that I get a proper funeral.

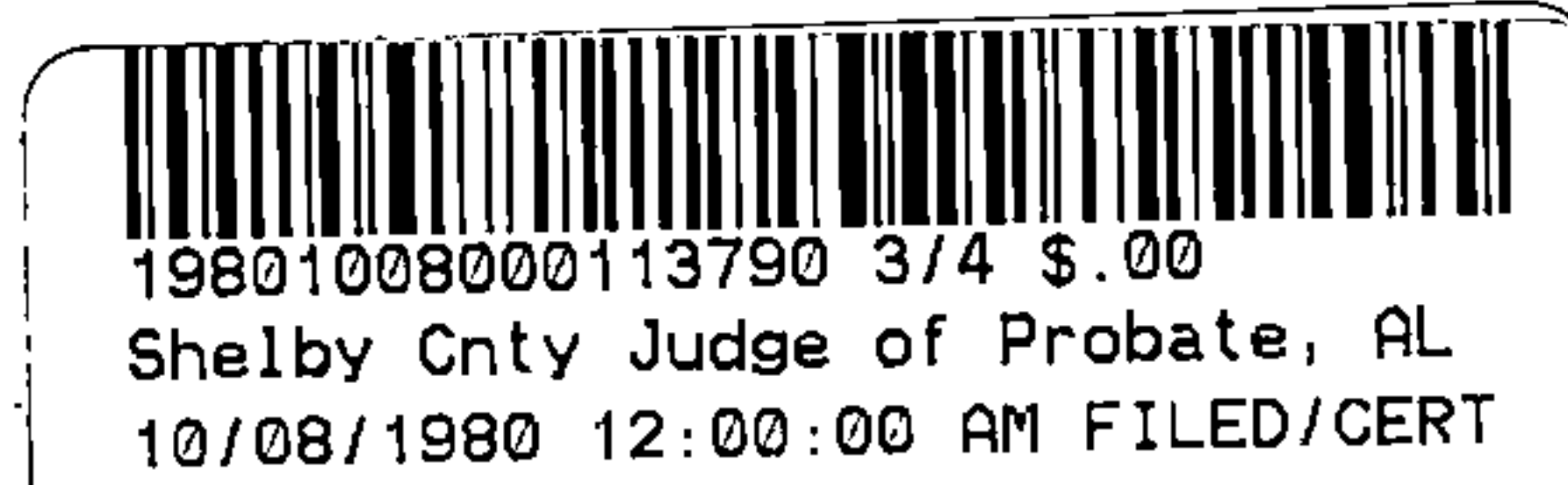
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VI.
