TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above granted property unto Mortgagee, Mortgagee's successors and assigns forever; and for the purpose of further securing the payment of said indebtedness, the undersigned agrees to pay all taxes or assessments when imposed legally upon said premises, and should default be made in the payment of same, Mortgagee may at Mortgagee's option pay off the same; and to further secure said indebtedness.
