
## AFFIDAVIT



I, Nellie Mae Saunders, hereby take oath and swear as follows: I am the only daughter of Martin Jones, who died intestate on 03 February 1955, and Mary Jones, who died intestate on 28 January 1976. Neither had any other children. Mary Jones remarried a Tom Adams in the mid 1960's, and Adams died intestate some 11 months later.

I have lived on the premises of Lot 11, Block 9, Thomas' addition to the Town of Aldrich, for more than the past 10 years, caring for Mary Jones, my mother. I have paid the taxes on the premises during this time, although the property is still assessed in her name.

These premises were conveyed to my parents on 17 September 1945 by a warranty deed from trustees of the Montevallo Coal Mining Company, which deed was recorded on 31 October 1945 at book 123, page 59 of the Shelby County Probate Records.

Tither of my parents conveyed title to this property during their lifetimes, and there are no outstanding mortgages, liens, or encumbrances on the property with the parteption
