WHEREAS, on February 29, 1980, a voluntary petition was filed by the above-named individual and in response to that petition he was adjudicated a bankrupt in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Alabama, Southern Division, Case No. 80-01199; and

was on March 4, 1980 appointed Trustee of the estate in this case, and he qualified as Trustee and entered into proper bond with sureties approved by Hon. Stephen B. Coleman, Bankruptcy Judge of said court, and that he has continued to act and is now acting and serving as such Trustee; and

WHEREAS, the Trustee did on September 16, 1980 petition the court for the right to sell at public sale, and for determination of liens and the court by order of September 24, 1980 did order the Trustee to sell the property described herein at public sale to the highest bidder for cash and did by that same order establish the priority of lien in the property; and

WHEREAS, the Trustee scheduled, properly advertised, caused notice to be issued to creditors and interested parties, and held a public sale of said property on October 21, 1980 at 12:00 noon; and

WHEREAS, United Federal Savings and Loan Association appeared at said sale and made the highest bid for said property in the amount of sixty thousand nine hundred seventy-four and 76/100 (\$60,974.76) dollars; and

WHEREAS, said sale was reported to the court by the Trustee and was confirmed by the court's order dated November 5, 1980, and the purchaser having paid to the Trustee the amounts necessary for payment of costs of the sale as set by the court and for satisfaction of prior liens except ad valorem taxes, which are assumed by the purchaser.
