Deposit as collateral, in lieu of claim against real property,

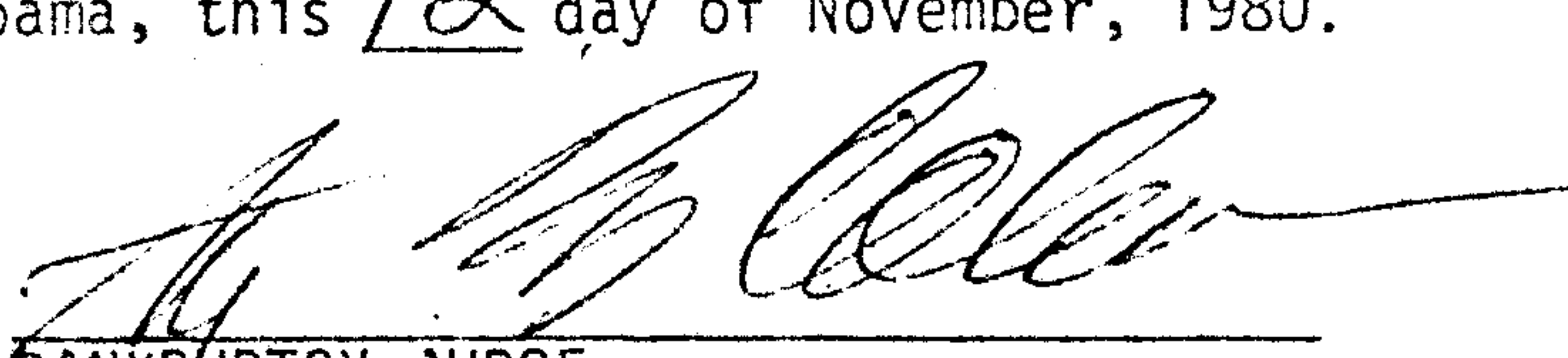
IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:
