WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR—LAWYERS TITLE INSURANCE CORPORATION, Birmingham, Alabama

JEFFERSON COUNTY } KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That in consideration of Thirty-Five Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-Nine & 68/100-- DOLLARS
to the undersigned grantor or grantors in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we,
Donald A. Schuster and wife, Therese Jeanne Schuster
(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
Fred R. Hipp and wife, Velma E. Hipp
(herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor
of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated
in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

Lot 31-A, according to a Resurvey, as recorded in
Map Book 7, Page 148, in the Office of the Judge
of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, of Lot 31,
in Block 1, of Kirkwall, a Subdivision of Inverness.

Subject to easements and restrictions of record.

And as further consideration the grantees herein ex-
pressly assume and promise to pay that certain mort-
gage to Real Estate Financing, Inc., recorded in Mort-

cording to the terms and conditions of said mortgage
and the indebtedness thereby secured.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said GRANTEES for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them,
then to the survivor of them in fee simple, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor forever, together with every contingent
remainder and right of reversion.

And I (we) do for myself (ourselves) and for my (our) heirs, executors, and administrators covenant with the said GRANTEES,
their heirs and assigns, that I am (we are) lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances,
unless otherwise noted above; that I (we) have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that I (we) will and my (our)
heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said GRANTEES, their heirs and assigns forever,
against the lawful claims of all persons.
