For the benefit of the Mortgagee, the buildings on said Premises shall be constantly insured against loss by fire and other haze casualities and contingencies, extended coverage, and other such coverage, in such manner and in such companies and for such amounts as be required by the Mortgagee, with loss, if any, payable to Mortgagee, as its interest may appear, and the Mortgagor does hereby tran assign, set over and deliver to the Mortgagee the fire and other insurance policies covering said property, and it is further agreed that all o security for said indebtedness shall pass to, and become the property of, the purchaser at any foreclosure sale hereunder, without the nece of notice, sale, deed or other proceedings in consummation of such foreclosure, and if the Mortgagor fails to keep said property insure above specified then the Mortgagee may, at its option, insure said property for its insurable value, against loss by fire and other haze casualties and contingencies, for its own benefit, and any amount which may be expended for premiums on such insurance policies sha secured by the lien of this mortgage and bear interest from the date of payment by the Mortgagee; it being understood and agreed between parties hereto that any sum, or sums, of money received for any damage by fire or other casualty to any building, or buildings, herein converting the parties hereto that any sum, or sums, of money received for any damage by fire or other casualty to any building, or buildings, herein converting the part, or, at the option of the holder of said debt, same may be paid over to a trustee, to be named by the Mortgagee, its successor assigns, to be applied in payment for any repair or replacement of such building, or buildings, or for any other purpose or object satisfactor said Mortgagee, without affecting the lien of this mortgage for the full amount hereby secured.

It is further agreed that if the Mortgagor shall fail to pay or cause to be paid in whole, or any portion, of the principal sum, or a installment of interest thereon, and any extensions or renewals thereof, or any other sum, the payment of which is hereby secured, as they or a of them mature, either by lapse of time or otherwise, in accordance with the agreements and covenants herein contained, or should default made in the payment of any mechanic's lien, materialmens' lien, insurance premiums, taxes or assessments now, or which may hereafter levied against, or which may become a lien on said property, or should default be made in any of the covenants, conditions and agreeme herein contained or in the construction loan agreement of even date herewith, then and in that event the whole of said principal sum, w interest thereon, and all other sums secured hereby shall, at the option of the then holder of said indebtedness, be and become immediately of and payable, and the holder of the debt secured shall have the right to enter upon and take possession of said property and sell after or with taking such possession of the same at public outcry, in whole or in parcels, in front of the Court House door of the county wherein said prope is located, to the highest bidder for cash, either in person or by auctioneer, after first giving notice of the time, place and terms of such sale publication once a week for three successive weeks in some newspaper published in said county, and, upon the payment of the purchase mon shall execute to the purchaser at said sale a deed to the property so purchased, the proceeds of such sale shall be applied (1) to the expen incurred in making the sale, including a reasonable attorney's fee for such services as may be necessary, in the collection of said indebtedness the foreclosure of the mortgage; (2) to the payment of whatever sum, or sums, the Mortgagee may have paid out or become liable to pay, carrying out the provisions of this mortgage, together with interest thereon: (3) to the payment and satisfaction of said principal indebtedness. and interest thereon to the day of sale and the balance, if any, shall be paid over to the Mortgagor, or assigns. If all or any part of the Premises shall be damaged or taken through condemnation (which term when used in this mortgage shall include any damage or taking by any governmental authority, and any transfer by private sale in lieu thereof), either temporarily or permanently, the entire indebtedness secured hereby shall at the option of the Mortgagee become immediately due and payable. The Mortgagee shall be entitled to all compensation, awards, and other payments or relief therefor and is hereby authorized, at its option, to commence, appear in and prosecute, in its own or the Mortgagor's name, any action or proceedings relating to any condemnation, and to settle or compromise any claim in connection therewith. All such compensation, awards, damages, claims, rights of action and proceeds and the right thereto are hereby assigned by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee, who, after deducting therefrom all its expenses, including attorney's fees, may release any moneys so received by it without affecting the lien of this mortgage or may apply the same in such manner as the Mortgagee shall determine to the reduction of the sums secured hereby, and any balance of such moneys then remaining shall be paid to the Mortgagor. The Mortgagor agrees to execute such further assignments of any compensations, awards, damages, rights of action, claims and proceeds as the Mortgagee may require.
