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I, the undersigned, hereby certify that Alabama Power Company does not claim the right to construct any additional lines for the transmission of electricity over or across the lands described herein below, under the authority granted in the following right-of-way permit:

That certain instrument from B. A. Chace and wife, Ruth B. Chace and F. A. Chace and wife, Dorothy A. Chace and George W. Chace and wife, Irene R. Chace to Alabama Power Company dated March 3, 1955 and recorded in Deed Book 173, page 359 in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama. (Parcel #146778)

The purpose for which such right-of-way permit was acquired was for distribution lines which were installed on and subsequently removed from the property described below:

34 914 The SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 3 West and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 19 South, Range 2 West, said power line extending from Southwest part of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ to the Northwest part of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$.

Also a 300 foot extension off existing power line in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 19 South, Range 3 West.
