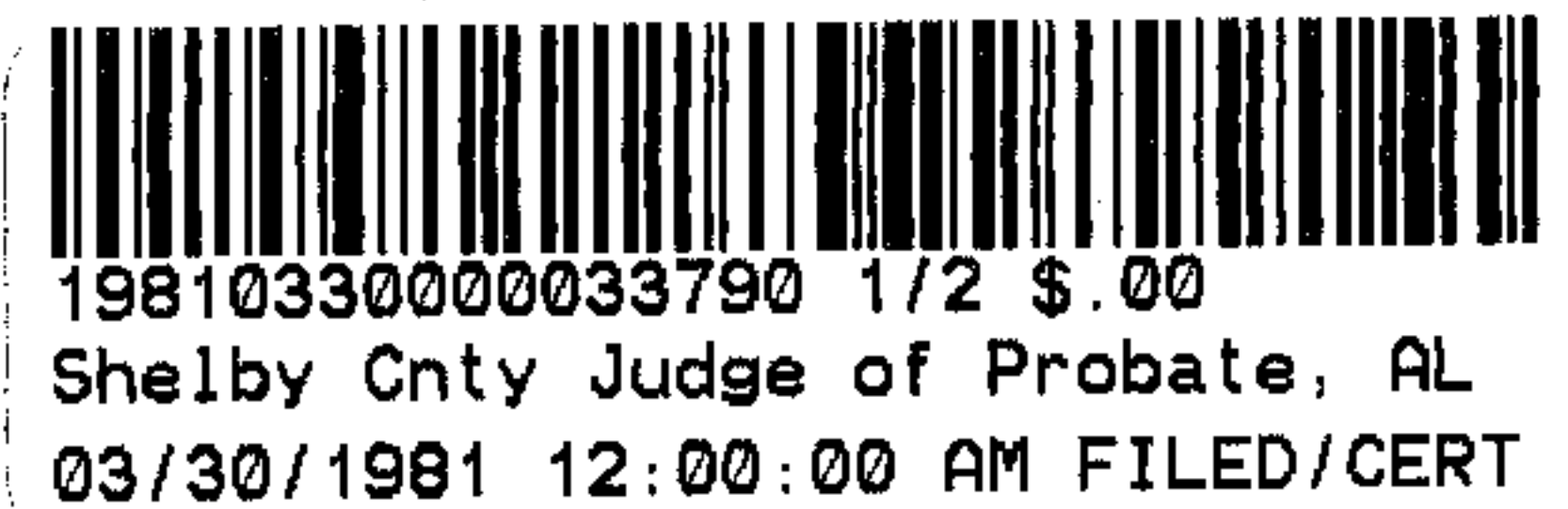

Before me, the undersigned authority, in and for said County in said State, personally appeared ELIZABETH B. DAVIS, who, being known to me and being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Elizabeth B. Davis. I am 60 years of age and my residence mailing address is at P. O. Box 107, Chelsea, Alabama 35043.

I am the wife of Judge J. Davis, and I have been familiar with the ownership, and possession of the following described property for more than the past 50 years, viz:

The S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama.

When I first became familiar with said property, it was owned by Mr. J. S. Black. ~~Mr. Black~~. Mr. Black conveyed a portion of said property to his daughter, Thelma Black, and her husband, M. S. Buck, more than thirty years ago. After the death of Mr. J. S. Black, Eula Black Nivens and Vera Black Griffin, who were daughters of said J. S. Black, conveyed their interests in and to the remainder of said property to their sister, Thelma Black Buck, in 1956, so that said Thelma Black Buck and her husband, M. S. Buck, became the owners of all the above described property in 1956. Said J. S. Black had no children, or descendants of deceased children, other than said Thelma Black Buck, Eula Black Nivens, and Vera Black Griffin.

The said M. S. Buck and wife, Thelma Buck, lived and resided in a house on said property from about 1946 until they sold and conveyed said property to my said husband, Judge J. Davis, and me, in 1964. When my said husband and I bought all of said property, that is, the entire S $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 1 West, from Mr. and Mrs. Buck in 1964, we moved in said house on said property and have continued to live and reside therein since 1964 until the present date.

My said husband, Judge J. Davis, and I, and our predecessors in title, as designated above, have been in the adverse, hostile, open, notorious, exclusive, actual, undisturbed, peaceable and continuous possession of the above described property for more than the past fifty years and until the present date. I have never heard anyone question the title, ownership, or right of possession of my husband and I or our predecessors in title, designated above. Specifically, I know that neither J. F. Cline, Talladega Grocery Company, nor Gordon T. Walch,
