THIS MORTGAGE IS MADE, however, subject to the following covenants, conditions, and agreements, that is to say:

1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note, at the times and --- in the manner therein provided. Privilege is reserved to pay the destin whole, or in an amount equal to one or more monthly payments on. the principal that are next due on the note, on the first day of any month prior to maturity; provided, however, that written notice of an intention to exercise such privilege is given at least thirty (30) days prior to prepayment.

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- 2. Together in addition to the monthly payments of principul and interest payable under the terms of the distributed hereby, the Mortgagor will pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month until said note is fully paid, the following sums:
 - (a) An amount sufficient to provide the holder hereof with funds to pay the next mortgage insurance premium if this instrument and the note secured hereby are insured, or a monthly charge (in lieu of a mortgage insurance premium) if they are held by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Develop---ment, as follows:
 - If and so long as said note of even date and this instrument are insured or are reinsured under the provisions of the National Housing Act, an amount sufficient to accumulate in the hands of the holder one (1) month prior to its due date the annual mortgage insurance premium, in order to provide such holder with funds to pay such premium to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to the National Housing Act, as amended, and applicable Regulations thereunder; or

If and so long as said note of even date and this instrument are held by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, a monthly charge (H)(in lieu of a mortgage insurance premium) which shall be in an amount equal to one-twelfth (1/12) of one-half (1/2) per centum of the average

(b) A sum equal to the ground rents, if any, next due, plus the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes and assessments next due on the mortgaged property. sums already paid therefor divided by the number of months to elapse before one mouth prior to the date when such ground rents, premiums, taxes and assessments will become delinquent, such sums to be held by Mortgagee in trust to pay said ground tents, premiums, taxes, and special assessments; and

All payments mentioned in the two preceding subsections of this paragraph and all payments to be made under the note secured hereby shall be addest together and the aggregate amount thereof shall be paid each month in a single payment to be applied by the Mortgagee to the following items in the order set forth:

premium charges under the contract of insurance with the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, or monthly charge (in lieu of mortgage insurance premium), as the case may be:

ground rents, taxes, special assessments, fire and other hazard insurance premiums; (III) interest on the note secured hereby; and

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(IV) amortization of the principal of said note.

Any deficiency in the amount of any such aggregate monthly payment shall, unless made good by the Mortgagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage. The Mortgagee may collect a "late charge" not to exceed four cents (4¢) for each dollar (§1) of each payment more than fifteen (15) days in arrears to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments.

3. If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding shall exceed the amount of the payments actually made by the Mortgagee for ground rents, taxes, assessments and insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess, if the loan is current, at the option of the Mortgagor, shall be credited on the subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, or refunded to the Mortgagor. If, however, the monthly payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding shall not be sufficient to pay ground rents, taxes, assessments, and insurance premiums, as the case may be, when the same shall become due and payable, than the Mortgagor will pay to the Mortgagee any amount necessary to make up the deficiency, on or before the date when payment of such ground rents, taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums shall be due. If at any time the Mortgagor shall tender to the Mortgagee, in payment of the entire indebtedness represented thereby, the Mortgagee shall, in computing the amount of such indebtedness, credit to the account of the Mortgagor all payments made under the provisions of (a) of paragraph 2 hereof which the Mortgagee has not become obligated to pay to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development and any balance remaining in the funds accumulated under the provisions of (b) of paragraph 2 hereof. If there shall be a default under any of the provisions of this mortgage resulting in a public sale of the premises covered hereby or if the Mortgagee acquired the property otherwise after default, the Mortgagee shall apply, at the time of commencement of such proceedings or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, the balance then remaining in the funds accumulated under (b) of paragraph? preceding, as a credit against the amount of principal then remaining unpaid under said note, and shall properly adjust any payments which shall have been made under (a) of paragraph 2.

4. If the Mark agree shall be made a party to any suit involving the title to the property hereby conveyed and employs an attorney to represent it therein, or if the Mortgagee employs an attorney to assist in settling or removing any cloud on the title to the property hereby conveyed that property to be superior to the lien of this mortgage in any respect, the Mortgagor will pay to the Mortgagee, when the same becomes due, such a torney's fee as may be reasonable for such services, and if such fee is paid or incurred by the Mortgagee the same shall be secured by the 🚋 of this mortgage in addition to the indebtedness specially secured hereby and shall bear interest from the date it is paid or incurred and shall be at once due and payable.

So long as any of the indebtedness secured hereby shall remain unpaid, in whole or in part, the Mortgagor agrees to keep said premises and the improvements thereon in good condition, and to pay all assessments that may be levied or accrue upon said property, and all other charges that may become liens upon said premises, and not to permit any lien, which might take precedence over the lien of this mort-

gage, to accrue and remain on said premises, or any part thereof, or on the improvements thereon.

6. The Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and assessments that may be assessed upon said property and all taxes except income taxes that may be assessed upon the Mortgagee's interest thereon or upon this mortgage or the moneys secured hereby, any law to the contrary notwithstanding. Upon any violation of this undertaking, or the passage of any law imposing upon the Mortgagee the payment of any part of the taxes aforesaid, or upon the rendition by any court of last resort of a decision that the undertaking to pay the taxes as aforesaid is legally inoperative, then, in any such event, the debt hereby secured shall at the Mortgagee's option, become immediately due and payable, without deduction, any law heretofore or hereafter enacted to the contrary notwithstanding.

7. That he will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property, insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and other hazards, casualties and contingencies in such amounts and for such periods as may be required by the Mortgagee and will pay promptly, when due, any premiums on such insurance provision for payment of which has not been made hereinbefore. All insurance shall be carried in companies approved by the Mortgagee and the policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee. In event of loss Mortgagor will give immediate notice by mail to the Mortgagee, who may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Mortgagor, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to the Mortgagee instead of to the Mortgagor and the Mortgagee jointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by the Mortgagee at its option either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged. In event of fereclosure of this mortgage or other transfer of title to the mortgaged property in extinguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or grantee.

8. If the Mortgagor fails to insure said property as hereinabove provided, or to pay all or any part of the taxes or assessments levied. accrued, or assessed upon or against said property or the indebtedness secured hereby, or any interest of the Mortgagee in either, or fails to pay immediately and discharge any and all liens, debts, and/or charges which might become liens superior to the lien of this mortrage, the Mortgagee may, at its option, insure said property and/or pay said taxes, assessments, debts, liens, and/or charges, and any money which the Mortgagee shall have so paid or become obligated to pay shall constitute a debt to the Mortgagee additional to the debt hereby specially secured, shall be secured by this mortgage, shall bear legal interest from date paid or incurred, and, at the option of the Mortgagee shall be immediately due and payable.

No tail no of the Mortgagee to exercise any option herein given to declare the maturity of the debt hereby secured shall be taken or construed is a warrer of its right to exercise such option or to declare, such maturity by reason of any past or present default on the part of the Mertpager, and the procurement of insurance or the payment of taxes or other liens, debts, or charges by the Mortgagee shall not be taken of constituee as a waiver of its right to declare the maturity of the indebtedness hereby secured by teason of the failure of the Moriga-
