
Pursuant to this Court's Orders dated January 7, 1981, and March 16, 1981, the Court appointed Trustee and Special Master, Harold H. Goings, commenced to take offers for the sale of the following described property owned by Groundhog, Inc., said property being situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

That the Court costs accrued herein are hereby taxed equally against the Plaintiff and Defendant.


