And the Mortgagor does hereby covenant with the Mortgagee that the Mortgagor is lawfully seized in fee of sai premises; that the Mortgagor has a good right to sell and convey the same; that said premises are free from incumbrance and that the Mortgagor warrants, and will forever defend the title to said premises against the lawful claims and demands o all persons whomsoever.

In case of sale under the power herein contained, the Mortgagee or any person authorized in writing by the Mortgagee shall have power to execute a conveyance to the purchaser, conveying all the right, title, interest, and claim of the Mortgagor in and to said premises, either at law or in equity. The Mortgagee may purchase said property at any sale hereunder and Secquire title thereto as could a stranger.

Out of the proceeds of sale the Mortgagee shall pay, first, the costs of advertising, selling, and conveying said property, rogether with a reasonable attorney's fee; secondly, the amount of the indebtedness due and owing to the Mortgages hereby secured, together with the interest thereon, and any taxes, insurance premiums, or other charges that the Mortgagee may have paid as herein provided; and lastly, the surplus, if any, shall be paid to the Mortgagor, or the Mortgagor's hairs or assigns.
