Before me, the undersigned, a Notary Public in and for said State, personally appeared O. L. Vincent whose name is signed to this Affidavit and who is known to me, and being by me first duly sworn deposes and says as follows:

That my name is O. L. Vincent and I was personally acquainted with James P. Weaver during his lifetime and know of my own knowledge that the said James P. Weaver departed this life on or about the 11th day of February, 1919 leaving no Last Will and Testament and that there has been no administration of his Estate.

That the said James P. Weaver left surviving him Martha Helen Weaver, his wife, and the following children: Philip Reid Weaver who departed this life on or about the 16th day of August, 1934 and left no issue surviving him and Ruth E. Weaver and Joseph L. Weaver, who are still living.

As shown by Deed recorded in Deed Book 59, Page 283, beginning November 15, 1915, the taxes were paid by James P. Weaver, until his death February 11, 1919. The taxes were then paid by his surviving widow, Martha Helen Weaver, in James P. Weaver's name until Martha Helen Weaver married W. O. Vincent on August 6, 1921.

The taxes were paid beginning August 6, 1921 in Mrs. W. O. Vincent's name until January 10, 1959 when property was deeded to Ruth Weaver Traywick and Joseph L. Weaver. Since January 10, 1959 until the present time, taxes have been paid by Ruth Weaver Traywick and Joseph L. Weaver, as shown by Deed Book 198, Page 320.

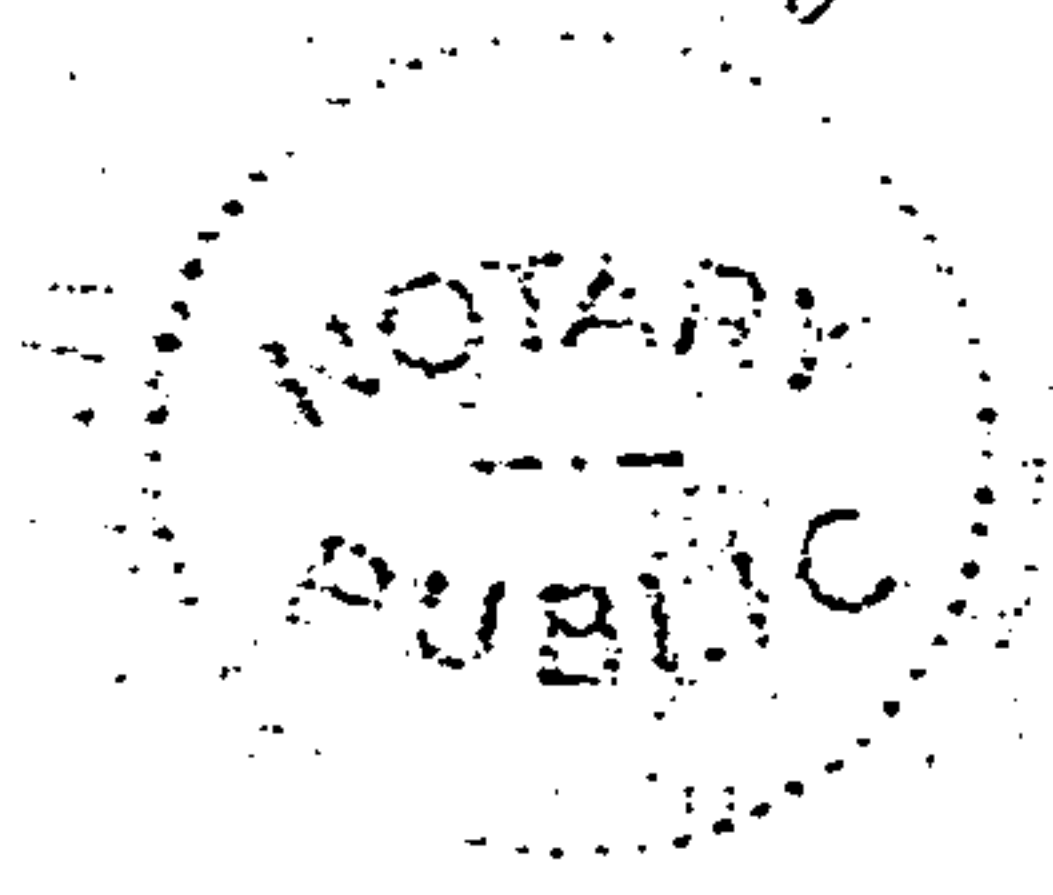
